Swimmer Scholar Program Attendance Policy

Trident Swim Foundation's goal is to develop a core of Swimmer Scholars who are competitive both in the pool and in the classroom. **Accordingly, attendance is mandatory following every school day.** Exceptions to this rule can be made ONLY on a case-by-base basis. Excused absences for jobs, doctor's visits, etc. will be granted ONLY with a signed note from a teacher or parent/guardian.

Swimmer Scholar Academic Achievement

As Swimmer Scholars, program participants are expected to attend regular school classes daily and will be provided an academic tracking sheet to improve the effectiveness of after-school tutoring. The Trident Swim Foundation reserves the right to use anonymized academic data for program evaluation purposes.

Swimmer Scholars have the responsibility to:

1. be prepared for practice at the beginning of each session with appropriate equipment and in a timely manner;
2. behave in a manner that contributes to a safe program environment and which does not interfere with other Swimmer Scholars' right to participate;
3. respect the dignity and equality of others and refrain from conduct which denies or impinges on the rights of others;
4. show respect for Trident Swim Foundation and School staff and property;
5. be polite, courteous and respectful toward others regardless of age, race, creed, color gender, gender identity, gender expression, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, physical and/or emotional condition, disability, marital status and political beliefs and refrain from making slurs based on these criteria;
6. promote good human relations and build bridges of understanding among Swimmer Scholars and the broader school community;
7. use non-confrontational methods to resolve conflicts;
8. refrain from obscene and defamatory communication in speech, writing and other modes of expression in their interactions with Trident Swim Foundation staff, Swimmer Scholars and Campus officials;
9. express themselves in a peaceful manner and respect the decisions of Swimmer Scholars who do not wish to participate in given activities;
10. provide leadership to encourage other Swimmer Scholars to follow established Trident Foundation policies and practices;
11. keep parents informed of program-related matters and requirements, including progress in school , social and educational events, and ensure that parents receive communications that are provided by school staff to students for transmittal to parents.
