**Required Merchandise & Fees**

The merchandise items listed below are an additional cost and not included in the aforementioned monthly payment schedule. These merchandise items will follow the listed payment dates and will be charged to the card on file. Please note that uniform pricing is currently an estimated cost; these prices will fluctuate based on the final design.

If an athlete does not wear the designated practice wear to a practice, he or she may be required to purchase an appropriate item and/or condition for not following dress code. If an athlete is removed or quits an ACE Cheer Company team at any point, following the 5:00pm, May 20th release date, you will continue to be responsible for fees in full. **ACE Cheer Company: Website Registration, Payment Procedures & Contractual Obligations**

Website Registration and Payment Authorization

ACE Cheer Company athletes must sign a automatic Bank draft form. A check or your bank account number and routing number is required for registration.

Monthly Payments

ACE monthly payment plans have been arranged to distribute the costs associated with competitive cheerleading (e.g., competition fees, etc.) in an affordable manner. In order to keep these fees at a lower cost, ACE Cheer Company distributes these expenses during the course of the entire season. Timely payments are expected from all ACE Cheer Company's parents.

- Monthly payments are automatically charged on the 5<sup>th</sup> of every month.
- Accounts not paid by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month will be assessed a \$25 late fee.



\*Late fees will not be waived if the account bounces on the 5th.

- All allstar fees/payments will be paid through our draft system. No cash or checks will be accepted monthly.
- If yearly allstar fees are paid at the beginning of the season, cash or check can be accepted.

#### Contractual Obligations

- The ACE Cheer Company Contract must be signed and received prior to Athlete Evaluations. This Contract is effective immediately and all financial obligations are agreed to by the person signing the Contract.
- Families will have until 5:00pm on Friday, May 20th to “be released” from their contract; however you will forfeit any and all fees paid, including any and all merchandise not received. You **must** see Garrette Burnette in person to notify him of your request to “be released” before the deadline in order to get out of your contract. If a request to “be released” is not timely made to Garrette Burnette on or before 5pm on Friday, May 20th, the Contract shall be in full force and effect, not subject to cancellation, and all payments required thereunder shall be due and payable as described in the Contract.
- *The May tuition is non-refundable!*
- If an athlete is removed or quits an ACE Cheer Company team at any point, following the 5:00pm, Friday, May 20th, release date, you will continue to be responsible for fees in full. These fees are to be paid in accordance with the assigned payment schedule and will be subject to late fees, interest at the maximum allowable rate under Mississippi law, and the costs of collection.
- If an athlete quits or is removed from an ACE team prior to receiving merchandise, you will **not** receive a refund for the purchase price or the merchandise. If an athlete is listed as an alternate, you will continue to be responsible for fees in full whether or not the athlete competes.
- **Tops may be required to take additional classes throughout the season to increase their skill sets for competition. These classes will incur additional fees outside of the listed monthly payments.**
- These, and all, decisions will be at the sole discretion of the gym owner and/or All-Star Director.

#### ACE Cheer Company: Fundraising Policy

- ACE does not offer and support any form of fundraising for individual athletes and or teams through ACE Cheer Company. Any and all fundraising activities that are organized outside of ACE may not use any form of the following: ACE name, ACE logo, ACE team name or any items that carry affiliation with the ACE Brand in any way (including, but not limited to, verbal messages, posters, electronic messaging, social media, clothing, etc.).

## **2022-2023 ACE Cheer Company Competitive Cheerleading Contract**

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the parent or legal guardian of (athlete.) The athlete desires to be a team member within the ACE Cheer Company competitive cheerleading program for the 2022-2023 season. The ACE Cheer Company Contract, the General All-Star Information Handbook, the Practice & Competition Information Handbook and the Contract & Schedule Handbook and attachments thereto (which are adopted and incorporated by reference and referred to herein collectively as the "ACE of Laurel Handbook") set forth the terms and conditions under which the athlete may participate in the 2022-2023 competitive cheerleading season as ACE Cheer Company team member.

### **Responsibilities of ACE Cheer Company**

ACE Cheer Company hereby agrees to provide competitive cheerleading coaches and instruction for the purpose of teaching cheerleading, tumbling, dance skills and techniques to athletes in preparation for local, regional and national cheerleading competitions and exhibitions. ACE Cheer Company does not and cannot guarantee that an athlete will acquire any particular skill level or that an athlete will remain on the same team throughout the entire season. All ACE Cheer Company cheerleading teams are fluid, so athletes can be moved from one team to another during a season, at the sole and absolute discretion of the ACE Cheer Company staff, as indicated within the ACE of Laurel Handbook. ACE Cheer Company and its agents, representatives, employees, owners, directors, and managers make no representations or warranties whatsoever about the services to be performed or the result set might be obtained. All warranties expressed and implied are expressly disclaimed by ACE Cheer Company.

### **Responsibilities of Athlete and Parent/Guardian**

I understand that accepting a place on an ACE Cheer Company competitive team is both an honor and a privilege, and that it entails a significant commitment to ACE Cheer Company and to fellow team members. Athlete hereby agrees to attend all practices and competitions, and understands that disciplinary actions that may be taken if the athlete does not comply with the attendance requirements set forth in the ACE of Laurel Handbook.

### **Parent/Guardian's Indemnification of ACE Cheer Company**

I hereby give my permission to ACE Cheer Company Staff to seek and give appropriate medical attention for the athlete during the period of practice or competition (or to/from) in the event of accident, injury or illness. I will be responsible for any and all cost of medical attention and treatment. I represent that the athlete is covered by medical insurance. I understand that, as with any sport, injuries can occur and the athlete is physically fit and mentally capable of participating in cheerleading, gymnastic, and dance activities. I represent that I have sought the opinion of an athlete's pediatrician/physician. I hereby waive, release and forever discharge ACE Cheer Company and its staff, employees, agents, coaches, managers, members, directors, affiliates and representatives from all rights and claims for damages, injury, or loss to person or property which may be sustained or occur during the athlete's participation in or involvement in any of ACE Cheer Company activities, whether on the ACE Cheer Company training facility premises or at any other venue where an ACE Cheer Company activity takes place, or in travel thereto or there from. I acknowledge that competitive cheerleading is an inherently dangerous sport in which I/my child participates at my/my child's own risk. In consideration of ACE Cheer Company allowing me/my child a position on a competitive cheerleading team, I, on behalf of myself, my heirs, assignees and personal representatives, do release and forever discharge ACE Cheer Company, its employees, agents, officers, members, sponsors, promoters and affiliates from any and all liability, damages, claims, losses, cost or expense, and waive and promise not to sue on any such claims against any such person or organization, arising directly or indirectly from or attributable in any legal way to any action or omission to act of any such person or organization or execution of any ACE Cheer Company-related cheerleading event (including, but not limited to, practices, events, travel to/from such an event) in which I, my child, or any member of our family or guest or ours will participate as a team member or spectator. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless ACE Cheer Company, its employees, agents, officers, members, sponsors, promoters and affiliates from any and all claims relating to or arising out of the ACE of Laurel Handbook in any way, including attorneys' fees incurred in connection with the enforcement of this indemnification.

I expressly agree that this release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Mississippi, and that if any portion of the agreement is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

### **Parent/Guardian's Travel Responsibilities**

I understand that:

- ACE Cheer Company assumes no responsibility to supervise or monitor athlete's activities or behavior during out of town events, except during the time the athlete is competing at the competition venue. I am responsible for my athlete's activities and behavior during out of town events, including travel to and from such events.

### **Choreography and Routine Acknowledgements**

- ACE Cheer Company Staff is solely responsible for, and retains full creative control of, the placement of the athlete on a particular team and all competitive routines, including, but not limited to, the placement of individual athletes in formations, the positions of individual athletes in stunts (e.g., base, back spots, front spot, top girl etc.), cheer and dance sequences.

### **Financial Obligations**

I have read and signed the ACE of Laurel Handbook. I understand that certain violations of team rules may subject the athlete to appropriate disciplinary actions as set forth in the ACE of Laurel Handbook. In the event the athlete's status on a team changes in any way, whether suspended or dismissed from the ACE Cheer Company program for disciplinary reasons, or moved to another team or placed as an alternate, I remain obligated to pay all costs and fees associated with having a spot on a team list for the entire 12 months and will receive no refunds of monies previously paid.



**Financial Obligations (continued)**

The ACE Cheer Company 2022-2023 Financial Obligations, which is part of the ACE of Laurel Handbook, dictates the exact payment amounts and provides a schedule when all payments are due. All financial obligations are considered a part of this agreement and incorporated by this reference thereto. I understand that:

1. The non-refundable May Tuition Fee and any outstanding balances must be paid in full on or before the date of my athlete's evaluation in order for my athlete to participate in evaluations.
2. Monthly payments must be paid on the 5th of each month for the following month from May 2022 through April 2023. I will be assessed a \$25 late fee if any monthly fee is not received by the 5th day of the month.
3. I am solely responsible for all travel costs associated with out-of-town competitions including transportation, lodging and food.
4. ACE Cheer Company is hereby authorized to initiate all payments owed through automatic credit card billing, as indicated on the authorization form attached hereto. I understand that ACE Cheer Company will initiate payment from my account or credit card on the 5th day of each month.
5. I will be assessed \$45 fee, per occurrence, of a check or authorized bank draft returned to ACE Cheer Company due to insufficient funds

**Limitation of Liability. IN NO EVENT SHALL ACE Cheer Company BE LIABLE TO ATHLETE, ANY MEMBER OF THE ATHLETE'S FAMILY, ANY PERSON WHO IS A GUEST OR INVITEE OF THE ATHLETE OR ATHLETE'S FAMILY AT ANY ACE FUNCTION (WHETHER PRACTICE, COMPETITION OR OTHERWISE), OR TO ANY THIRD PARTY FOR ANY LOSS OF USE, REVENUE, OR PROFIT OR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, EXEMPLARY, SPECIAL, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES WHETHER ARISING OUT OF BREACH OF CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), OR OTHERWISE, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH DAMAGE WAS FORESEEABLE AND WHETHER OR NOT ACE Cheer Company HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES, AND NOTWITHSTANDING THE FAILURE OF ANY AGREED OR OTHER REMEDY OF ITS ESSENTIAL PURPOSE. IN NO EVENT SHALL ACE Cheer Company's AGGREGATE LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THIS AGREEMENT, WHETHER ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO BREACH OF CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), OR OTHERWISE, EXCEED THE AGGREGATE AMOUNTS PAID OR PAYABLE TO ACE Cheer Company PURSUANT TO THIS AGREEMENT.**

**Choice of Law. This Agreement and all related documents, including all exhibits attached thereto, and all matters arising out of or relating to this Agreement, including the ACE of Laurel Handbook and whether sounding in contract, tort, or statute are governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Mississippi, without giving effect to conflict of laws provisions thereof to the extent such principles or rules would require or permit the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than those of the State of Mississippi.**

**CHOICE OF FORUM. EACH PARTY IRREVOCABLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY AGREES THAT IT WILL NOT COMMENCE ANY ACTION, LITIGATION OR PROCEEDING OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER AGAINST THE OTHER PARTY IN ANY WAY ARISING FROM OR RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, INCLUDING ALL EXHIBITS, SCHEDULES, ATTACHMENTS AND APPENDICES ATTACHED TO THIS AGREEMENT, AND ALL CONTEMPLATED TRANSACTIONS, INCLUDING CONTRACT, EQUITY, TORT, FRAUD AND STATUTORY CLAIMS, IN ANY FORUM OTHER THAN THE STATE COURTS LOCATED IN JONES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI (Laurel DIVISION) OR FEDERAL COURTS WITHIN THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF MISSISSIPPI (SOUTHERN DIVISION) AND ANY APPELLATE COURT FROM ANY THEREOF. EACH PARTY IRREVOCABLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY SUBMITS TO THE EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION OF SUCH COURTS AND AGREES TO BRING ANY SUCH ACTION, LITIGATION OR PROCEEDING ONLY IN THE STATE OR FEDERAL COURTS OF JONES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI (Laurel DIVISION) OR FEDERAL COURTS WITHIN THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF MISSISSIPPI (SOUTHERN DIVISION). EACH PARTY AGREES THAT A FINAL JUDGMENT IN ANY SUCH ACTION, LITIGATION, OR PROCEEDING IS CONCLUSIVE AND MAY BE ENFORCED IN OTHER JURISDICTIONS BY SUIT ON THE JUDGMENT OR IN ANY OTHER MANNER PROVIDED BY LAW.**

**WAIVER OF JURY TRIAL.
