AUSTRALIAN SKINS AN EXPLANATION



- Australian Skins is fun and different way to conduct competition
- The premise is the event being competed in has multiple elimination rounds
- Elimination occurs until there are a final two competitors to become the Ultimate Champion



EXAMPLE

Event 30 is the Girls 50 breaststroke. The event has a Prelim/Semi/Final Round.

There are 65 entries in Event 30. Below is how the event plays out.

- 1. The 65 Entries will compete. The top 8 will be identified and move to the Semis.
- 2. The Semis will occur after Event 31 completes its Prelim round.
- 3. The Semis has 8 swimmers. The top 6 advance to finals and will swim within a couple minutes in Event 30's 'Final' round.
- 4. The Finals has 6 swimmers. The top 4 will advance to Event 130 Prelims (the 4th round) and again, will swim within a couple minutes.
- 5. Event 130 'Prelims' has 4 swimmers. The top 2 advance to Event 130's Final Round. This will occur at the end of the session (after all 50 free rounds).
- 6. Event 130 'Finals' has 2 swimmers. They race it out to be the Ultimate Champion.
