

BMA Code of Conduct

As a BMA member, I agree:

1. To comply fully with all pool regulations and the direction of the pool staff.
2. To follow all directions given by coaches, meet, or pool officials.
3. To not use vulgar or insulting language directed toward any persons while at any BMA activity including meets, practices, trips, or other team gatherings.
4. To not engage in physically aggressive behavior including pushing, shoving, hitting, or other contact directed toward any other person while at any BMA activity including meets, practices, trips, or other team gatherings.
5. To not engage in any activities that would be a violation of USA Swimming or Montana Swimming LSC rules, including rules regarding bullying, sexual misconduct, or sexual abuse.
6. To be courteous to all swimmers, coaches, competitors, and other participants at BMA and USA swimming activities.

Violations of this code of conduct may be grounds for disciplinary action.

The BMA Board will contact the persons involved to discuss any serious or repeated infractions. Any violation that causes or has the potential to cause injury to another person or significantly disrupts any BMA or USA Swimming function is a serious violation. The BMA Board, coaches, parents, and swimmer will meet to discuss serious violations and design a plan for resolution.

Swimmer and parents agree to the code of conduct and will abide by it.
