BMA's Swimming Scholarship Program

Bozeman Multisport Aquatics has received grant funding and donations to support scholarships for athletes from economically disadvantaged households or ethnically underrepresented populations. Your application is confidential and will be handled by the Scholarship Committee comprised of the BMA Treasurer, the Head Deck or Head Administrative Coach and one other board member. Separate applications must be filled out for each athlete in a family. Awards within families may vary depending upon circumstances and availability of funds.

1. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend practice regularly and comply with Bozeman Multisport Aquatic's Athlete Code of Conduct and the USA Swimming Athlete Code of Conduct to receive their scholarship for the season.
2. Scholarship recipients may be awarded a partial reduction of the dues for a season and funds to cover USA Swimming Registration, provided they qualify under Montana Swimming's definition of Outreach Athletes.
3. Scholarship recipients are required to participate in the fall Swim-a-thon where it is expected that they raise the required \$100 minimum in donations for the team.
4. Scholarships may be awarded for short course (Sept. – Mar.), long course (Apr.- July) or Splash Camp, provided funds are available. Each scholarship is only good for the length of the season/camp for which it was awarded.
5. Scholarships are awarded for a portion of dues only. Scholarship recipients are responsible for paying for any equipment, t-shirts, caps ordered from the team and for meet entry fees which can range from \$60-80 per meet, depending on location and # of swim events chosen.
6. Being awarded a scholarship in one season does not guarantee scholarships in the future. A new scholarship application must be submitted for subsequent seasons.
7. Applicants agree to provide documentation, if requested, for the Scholarship Committee to verify the information provided.
