
There are several activities that happen each year. We have appreciated the help in the past and look forward to working with everyone going forward.

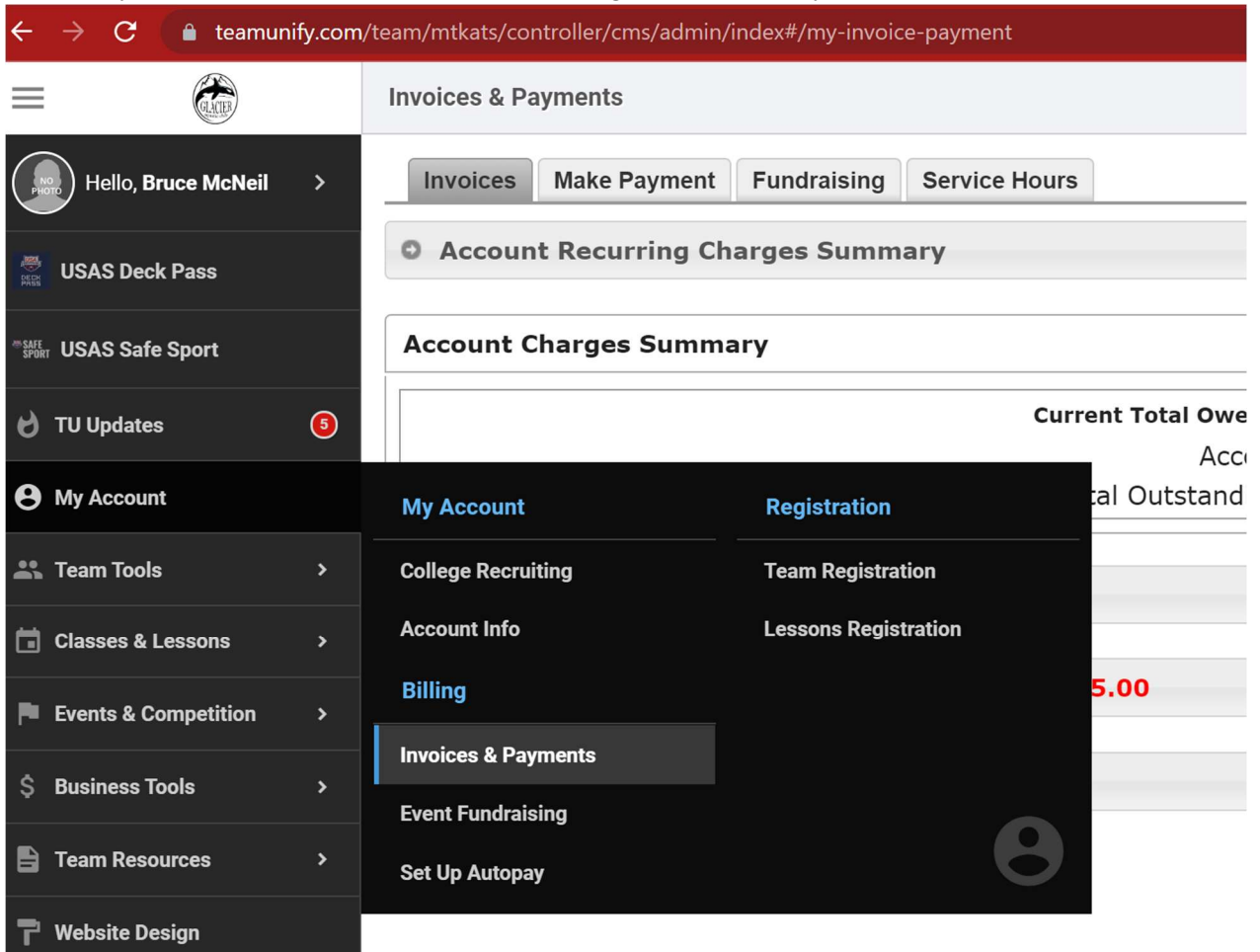
