The 17-19 year old age group has been changed to 17 and over. The 17-18 year old qualifying times are the state qualifying times for this age group. Swimmers must be registered athlete members of Montana Swimming to compete in the championship meets.

Swimmers, you are invited to submit a design for the Spirit Award banners. Montana Swimming will have two new spirit banners made in August and we need a design for the banner. The banners are white with navy trim and state "Montana Swimming Short Course (or long course) Spirit Award". The current banners have a navy megaphone for the design. Designs can be no larger than 12" x 18" and should be in one or possibly two colors. Please send your designs to me by July 21. We will vote on the designs during LC State. Finally, please be aware that our Montana Swimming – USA Swimming dues will increase as of September 1, 2003. The dues increase is from the national organization. The athlete dues will increase to \$60 per swimmer. Seasonal athlete dues will increase to \$32.50. Non-athlete dues will increase to \$50 and non-athlete family dues will increase to \$85. The dues will then increase a dollar per year until 2014.
