Damage to the facility, when proved, will cause the offending swimmer, if unattached, or the offending swimmer's team, if attached, to be held accountable for repairs.

Outdoor competition tank, 50 meters by 25 yards, 8 lanes, 2.5 meters per lane. The west end of the competition course is 16.0 feet deep; the east end of the pool is 6.0 feet deep. Electronic timing and matrix scoreboard systems added during the 2007 renovation. Indoor 25-yard, 6-lane tank serves as the warmup pool, and runs from 3.5 feet deep to 13.0 feet deep. Outdoor stadiumstyle seating for 3,000 spectators, plus a team seating area for 800+ athletes. Pool Certification

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 C (4). and is on file with USA Swimming.



MEET FORMAT

- Meet format will be LCM Prelims (8 lanes) and LCM Finals (8 lanes). One championship heat and one consolation heat will compete in Finals, except as noted in the Order of Events, (A) below.
- Order of seeding will be Long Course Meters (LCM), Short Course Yards (SCY), Short Course Meters (SCM).
 Bonus events will be seeded after the above, in the same order: BLCM-BSCY-BSCM.
- Preliminary Heats of Individual Events and all Individual Timed Finals Events will be seeded and swum Fastest to Slowest.
 See Order of Events, (A) & (B) below, for additional information on Individual Timed Finals Events.
- Circle-Seeding Top 3 heats of preliminary individual events 200M or less, and top 2 heats of preliminary individual events of 400M will be circle-seeded, with the fastest athlete in heat 3 for events 200M or less, and in heat 2 for events of 400M, respectively.
- Finals Heats of Individual Events will be seeded and swum Slowest to Fastest: Consolation, Championship, except as noted in the Order of Events, (A) below.
- ALL RELAYS will be conducted as Timed Finals, swum Slowest to Fastest, in event order, at the conclusion of their respective Finals sessions.
 No Relays will be swum in the Preliminary sessions. There will be a 10-min break immediately prior to the start of the relay events.
- Chase Starts will be used at this meet for all Preliminary events, except the following: all 50M events and the 800M/1500M Freestyles.
 - > ALL 50M events will start at the EAST/SCOREBOARD end for both Prelims and Finals.
 - > 800M/1500M Freestyles heats will start at the WEST end
- Finals Events will start from the WEST end, including relays, except for 50M events, which start at the EAST/SCOREBOARD end
- Finals Ready Room A Finals Ready Room will be used to parade the Championship heat of Finals events. The fastest seeded heat of all Timed Finals events swimming in Finals will also be paraded. Athletes must report to the Ready Room no later than five minutes prior to their event. All relays will report directly to the starting blocks.

Rules

- Current USA Swimming rules will govern this meet. Any relevant sections of the Oregon Swimming Policies & Procedures Manual
 will also apply. Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm Up procedures will be in effect at this meet.
- The age of the athlete will be his/her age as of August 7, 2019, the first day of competition.
- All athletes entered in the meet must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. Any swimmer without a coach in attendance must report to the Meet Director or Meet Referee who may assist an athlete in making supervision arrangements, but it is the athlete's responsibility to make these arrangements prior to the start of the meet and to so notify the Meet Referee.
- Any athlete entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start, including both a Forward Start and a Backstroke Start, or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the athlete or the athlete's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement and to bring proof of such certification to the meet.
- The Spectrum Backstroke Ledge starting device will be available at this meet, and its use is optional. LSC Coaches are responsible certifying, during Tuesday's supervised warm-ups, all athletes who wish to use the backstroke starting device who are not already certified to use it.
- It shall be the athletes' and coaches' responsibility to acquaint themselves with all the information in this Meet Announcement and any information and changes announced at the General Meeting.
- Athletes and coaches are responsible for being familiar with this meet's scratch rules and relay confirmation procedures.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not allowed in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.
- Photography is not allowed behind the blocks during the start of a race or relay exchange.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- All athletes entered in the competition must comply with current USA Swimming rules regarding swimwear.

TECH SUITS:

Effective April 1, 2019, OSI Sanctioned Events Prohibit Tech Suit Use by 12U Athletes, including the 2019 WZAG Championships.

USA Swimming defines a Technical Suit as one that has the following components:

- Any suit with any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette; or
- > Any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips.

WOVEN FABRIC – A suit with woven fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted.

KNIT FABRIC – A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted.

Current Certification in Concussion Training is REQUIRED in Oregon for ALL Coaches and Meet Referees. Proof of current
certification will be required in order to receive meet credentials. Complete information can be found at www.oregonswimming.org
under "Coaches – Registration – Concussion Training Certification".

Restrictions

- This is a CLOSED-DECK meet.
 - > Only athletes, coaches, officials, team chaperones, and assigned meet volunteers will be permitted on the competition deck.
 - > Only athletes, coaches, officials, team chaperones, and others with appropriate credentials will be permitted in the Athlete Village.
- Tobacco products of any kind, vaping, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue.
- Shaving is not permitted anywhere in the facility.
- Service animals only allowed in the facility.

Athlete Supervision and Safety

Per Western Zone policy, each LSC is required to have at least one adult chaperone in the Athletes' Village supervising their LSC athletes whenever their athletes are in the Athletes Village. Teams are encouraged to monitor the location of their athletes in the venue when they are not actively competing.

Meet Marshals will be present to assist in the monitoring of athletes in the warm-up area, and on the competition deck. Additionally, occasional sweeps of the locker rooms will be performed (women checking girls locker rooms & men checking boys locker rooms).

Broadcast Statement

Photographs, videotape, audio, and/or other visual recordings of the event created by a spectator may be used solely for such spectator's personal non-commercial use and may not be broadcast, published, disseminated or used for any commercial purpose without the prior consent of USA Swimming.

Image Authorization

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of the 2019 Western Zone Age Group Championship under the conditions authored by USA Swimming. Event organizers are additionally granted the right to use the pictures, likeness, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions.



Eligibility

This meet is open to athletes who:

- 1. Are currently registered year-round members of USA Swimming for 2019. There will be no on-deck USA Swimming registration.
- 2. Are currently registered with a USA Swimming LSC of the Western Zone as of the day meet entries close, July 31, 2019.
- 3. Are no older than 14 years of age as of the first day of the meet, August 7, 2019.
- 4. Have been approved by their LSC to participate in this meet.
- 5. Have met the appropriate 2019 qualifying times in competition between August 8, 2018, and the entry deadline, July 31, 2019.
- 6. Have qualifying entry times achieved at USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competitions. Entry times not in the SWIMS database must be proven to the Administrative Referee or designated representative by the LSC upon request. Failure to provide such proof of time will result in a \$250.00 fine to the athlete's LSC, the removal of the athlete from the meet, and all earned points (including relay points) removed from the LSC scoring. It is the responsibility of the entering LSC to verify that entry times are in SWIMS or to provide proof of times. Proof of relay entry times is not required.
- 7. An athlete who has, within the 18 months prior to the start of the meet, participated in one (1) individual event at a USA Swimming Championship as defined by Article 207 of the USA Swimming Rulebook, excluding Disability Championships and Open Water Championships, may not compete in that event or the related relay leg at this meet. An athlete who has competed in two (2) or more individual events may not compete at this meet.
- 8. Athletes with disabilities: Each LSC may bring two (2) athletes with disabilities ages 12 and under, and two (2) athletes with disabilities, ages 13-14. Athletes with disabilities are not required to meet the qualifying time standards for their age group; however, they must provide a time for each event entered. Classification of disability does not apply for this meet.

ENTRIES

*** Entry Qualifying Time Period: August 8, 2018 to July 31, 2019 ***

All entries must be submitted via email by the competing LSC using a USA Swimming approved Standard Database Interchangeable Format (SDIF) electronic entry file.

Entry Deadline: Wednesday * July 31, 2019 * 5:00 pm (PDT)

- All entries shall be submitted ONLY by the LSC Team Entry Representative, on behalf of the LSC.
- With the submission of entries, the Team Entry Representative attests that all athletes entered are registered with USA Swimming.
- Submitted entries must include an athlete's full legal name, age, USA Swimming ID number, and LSC team code.
- Altitude Adjustment of Entry Times: Meet qualifying times are stated at sea level; however, times achieved at an altitude of 3,000 feet or above may be adjusted in accordance with current USA Swimming policies.
- Designation of Non-Conforming & Bonus Times:
 - > Qualifying short course times shall be designated in the entry file with a "Y" for short course yards and a "S" for short course meters.
 - > Entries not meeting the qualifying time standard shall be designated with a "B" for bonus swim, in addition to the course designation: "L" LCM, "Y" SCY, or "S"- SCM. Eg: 1:01.55BL * 55.55BY * 59.59BS
 - Converted times are not allowed.

Entry Limits

Individual

Athletes may enter up to six (6) individual events total but may not compete in more than three (3) individual events per day.

- Team
 - > Each LSC athlete roster is limited to no more than 80 athletes total, not including athletes with disabilities.
 - > Each LSC may enter up to 400 individual events; however no more than 160 may be slower than the qualifying time standards. Entry times slower than the qualifying time standard are to be designated as "Bonus" (see Entries, above).
 - > LSCs with entries exceeding 400 individual events and/or 160 "bonus" events, shall scratch down to the stated limits prior to the close of the scratch box on Tuesday, fifteen (15) minutes after the end of the General Meeting. Failure to comply shall be deemed to have given the Meet Referee the authority to eliminate entries to comply with the stated limits. "Bonus" swims will be scratched first. Entries for athletes with disabilities are not included in the stated LSC limits.
 - Each LSC is limited to one (1) "bonus" swim per gender, per age group, for events 400M or longer. Entries exceeding this limit must be scratched prior to the close of the scratch deadline for the event. If the LSC fails to scratch excessive entries, the Admin Referee shall have the authority to eliminate entries to comply with the stated limits. "Bonus" swims will be scratched first. Entries for athletes with disabilities are not included in the stated LSC limits.



Entry Limits, con't

- Relay Entries:
 - Each LSC is limited to two (2) relays per relay event
 - > Entry times for relays are required when meet entries are submitted. Proof of relay entry times is not required.
 - > Relays must be made up of athletes entered in the meet whose age and gender meet the event description. Athletes are limited to one age group relay per session.
 - Relays will be scored, awards presented, and records kept for the following age groups: 10&U, 12&U, 14&U.
- NO REFUNDS will be given for submitted entries that are subsequently scratched by either an LSC's coach, the Meet Referee, or the Admin Referee.

Entry Fees

- \$9.00 per individual event entry (\$4.00 paid by Oregon Swimming to Zone Treasury)
- \$16.50 per relay entry (\$4.00 paid by Oregon Swimming to Zone Treasury)
- > ALL PAYMENTS due to Oregon Swimming for entry fees and other items will be made ON-SITE at the General Meeting via CREDIT CARD or CHECK, made payable to Oregon Swimming.
- > NO REFUNDS will be given for submitted entries that are subsequently scratched by either an LSC's coach, the Meet Referee, or the Admin Referee

- Receipt of entries is not considered confirmed until the LSC Team Entry Representative receives a confirmation email from Meet Director Jody Rash. If an entry confirmation email is not received within 24 hours of the meet entry deadline, contact Meet Director Jody Rash immediately.
- > PRINT hard copies of Individual and Relay entries submitted and bring to meet as reference documents.
- ALL PAYMENTS due to Oregon Swimming for entry fees and other items will be made ON-SITE at the General Meeting via CREDIT CARD or CHECK, made payable to Oregon Swimming.

Administrative Entry Errors

Entries for an athlete that are incorrect due to administrative error may be corrected if the following requirements are met:

- 1. The LSC entering the athlete can prove, with documentary evidence, to the satisfaction of both the Meet Referee and the Meet Director that the administrative error is exclusively the fault of the LSC and not in any way the fault of the athlete.
- 2. Such documentary evidence must be submitted to the Meet Referee or the Meet Director <u>prior</u> to the General Meeting (NO exceptions) where it will be subject to approval. If approved, the athlete shall be seeded correctly.

Late Entries

Late entries will only be accepted in accordance with the Western Zone Swimming Championship Regulations, Section VII.9.5.10. In summary:

An LSC whose entire entry is received no more than 24 hours late, may enter its athletes into the Western Zone Age Group Swimming Championship subject to the following:

- > The late LSC shall pay to the meet host an administrative penalty equal to that LSC's total entry fees.
- > The late LSC shall not score points for its individual swims but shall receive points from all its swum relays.
- The late LSC's swimmers shall be seeded correctly, shall earn individual awards and times of record.

Registration & Team Check-In / Clerk of Course

All athletes, coaches, officials, and team managers participating in this competition must be currently registered for 2019 with USA Swimming.

- All athletes, coaches, officials and team managers should be prepared to present their USA Swimming ID Card or Deck Pass as proof of their registration to the Meet Referee, the Meet Director, or their designee at any time. Photo ID may also be requested.
- All athletes, coaches, officials and team managers (including designated team chaperones) will receive a meet-specific credential, which will serve as a deck pass, and is to be displayed in order to access the competition deck and team areas.
- Current Certification in Concussion Training is REQUIRED in Oregon for ALL Coaches and Meet Referees. Proof of current certification will be required in order to receive meet credentials. - Athletes will have 30 minutes after the announcement of finals event qualifiers to declare their intention to scratch from final events and must declare their final intention to scratch or swim within 30 minutes of their last individual preliminary event of that session.
- Any athlete seeded in an individual finals event who does not properly declare their intention to scratch and fails to compete in that finals event will be barred from competition for the remainder of the meet.

Scratch Procedures for Individual Events
