Entry Qualification:

Any swimmer, ages 9-21 that qualified for Montana Short Course State meet with a BB or faster time since January 1, 2021, are ineligible to enter any events in which they have a B time or faster, they may enter any event in which their best time in any course is a B time or SLOWER in the qualifying period since January1, 2021

8 and Under swimmers may enter any event they do not have a state qualifying time in any course in qualifying period since January 1, 2021.

No time entries will be accepted.

All swimmers must be 2022 registered athlete members of Montana Swimming.

Team Competition: The top team will receive a special Team Champion banner to display at their home pool for the coming year.

Facility

The Bozeman Swim Center, located on the west side of Bozeman High School at 1211 West Main Street, is an 8-lane, 50-meter regulation long course pool. A bulkhead has been installed dividing the pool into both 25-yard and 25-meter courses. This meet will be held in the regulation 25-yard course. The 25-meter course will be available for coach-monitored warmup/cool down as described herein. The racing course is equipped with Kiefer Advantage I non-turbulent lane lines and Spectrum Xcellerator starting blocks.

The altitude is 4793 feet. The competition pool is 9-feet deep at the start end and 5-feet deep at the turn end. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

An automatic Colorado Timing System will be used with touch pads at both ends in addition up to three backup times. An 8-line LED scoreboard will be in use.

Directions: From I-90, arriving either east or west bound, take exit 306 onto N 7th Avenue, Turn south onto North 7th Avenue and travel 1.2 miles to West Main Street. Turn right (west) onto W Main Street. The Bozeman Swim Center will be on your right in 0.5 miles, just past the Bozeman High School.

OVERNIGHT PARKING OR CAMPING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE PARKING LOTS ADJACENT TO THE SWIM CENTER.

Meet Format

This is an age group timed finals meet. The meet referee reserves the right to split the meet into two sessions depending on the number of athletes registered.

Individual events will be swum as combined age groups as listed in the entry list. All individual events will be scored as 8 and under, 10 and under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 and 17-21 boys and girls for each age group. All events will start from the starting block end of the pool.

The 1000 yard freestyle and 500 yard freestyle will be swum as mixed gender, fastest to slowest but will be scored and awarded by age group and gender. Swimmers in the 500 Free and 1000 free must provide their own timers and counters.

At the meet Referee's discretion, events may be combined by age, gender, provided there is at least one empty lane between such combined events. The referee may waive the empty lane requirement with the concurrence of the coaches of the affected swimmers. At the discretion of meet management and the Meet Referee, depending on the number athletes and the timeline, periodic breaks in the competition cycle may be provided.

If only a few swimmers are entered into an event, other events may be combined, seeded, and swum as a mixed event at the meet referee's discretion, but will be scored and awarded by sex and age group.

Relays will be seeded as girls, boys and mixed. Turn in relay cards at the meet. Mixed relays must be 2 boys and 2 girls all the age required by the event, description to be scored and to have the time entered in SWIMS. Relay events/ heats maybe combined at the meet referee's discretion.

Only swimmers, coaches and officials will be allowed on the north end of the swim center behind the blocks and on the west wall by the coach's tables.

Safety

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID - 19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID- 19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. USA Swimming Inc, cannot prevent you (or your children) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID -19 while participating in a USA swimming/USMS sanctioned event. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to participate in a USA Swimming/USMS sanctioned event, you may be exposing yourself to and /or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID -19.

By attending or participating in this competition, you voluntarily assume all risks associated with exposure to COVID-19 and forever release and hold harmless USA Swimming and the Montana Swimming LSC and each of their officers, directors, agents, employees or other representatives from any liability or claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property loss, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claims you may have to see damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, in connection therewith.

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures. You must follow all posted instructions while in the Swim Center at all times while attending this meet. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID -19 exists in any public place where people are present. By attending this meet, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID 19.

Due to specific usage restrictions, there will be a limit of 2 spectators per athlete. Spectators are to remain in the gym until their swimmer is competing. There will be no camping in the swim center. The meet will be broadcast live though Facebook Live at our public Facebook page titled Bozeman Barracudas Public.

In applying for this sanctioned meet, the Bozeman Barracuda Swim Club agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Montana Swimming, the State of Montana and Gallatin County.

Masks and socially distancing will be recommended at all times during the meet except when actively swimming. Please do not attend if you are sick, including but not limited to a fever, muscle aches, sore throat, cough, or gastrointestinal upset. If you have been exposed or have been identified as a close contact of someone testing positive for COVID -19 or have tested positive yourself.

The Montana Swimming Safety guidelines are in effect for this meet and will be enforced. For circle swimming during warm-ups and cool-downs, swimmers must enter the pool using a three-point entry. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated. Warm up/ cool down in the shallow end of the non-competition pool on the other side of the bulkhead will be allowed only with strict coach supervision.

Operation of a drone, or any flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/ coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present.

A Safety Marshall will be on deck during the meet.

Time Trials

At the Meet Referee's discretion, time trials will be available on Saturday March 5, 2022 following the 500 Free. There will be a brief warm up for any swimmers who wish to swim time trial events. The time trial event will last no longer than one hour. Any Montana registered USAS athlete is eligible to enter a time trial event. Registration will be verified. Athletes entered in the Junior B/C Championships may not swim more than 5 individual events on Saturday March 5, 2022, inclusive of time trial events. Athletes not registered in the Junior B/C Championships meet may swim no more than two time trial events. Swimmers may swim any event swum in a Montana Swimming Championships meet. Time trial athletes must provide their own timers (two). Events may be combined to get as many time trials in as possible Time trials will cost \$15 per event. Must be paid in cash and entered on Saturday. There will be no advanced entry for time trials. Time trial signups will begin at 9am and close prior to the start of Event 49.

Racing Starts

Any swimmer who is entered in the meet and is unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Any swimmers who must start in the water shall be listed in a separate document returned with the entries.

Rules

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming and Montana Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms or behind the blocks at the start end of the pool.

There will be no deck changing allowed. USA Swimming tents will be provided.

THERE WILL BE LIMITED USE OF THE LOCKER ROOMS FOR SHOWERING AND CHANGING WITH A CAP OF 10 SWIMMERS ALLOWED IN THE LOCKER ROOM AT A TIME. WE ASK THAT TIME IN THE LOCKER ROOM BE KEPT TO 5 MINUTES OR LESS AND A MASK IS RECOMMENDED WHILE IN THE LOCKER ROOM EXCEPT TO SHOWER. WHILE IN THE SHOWER YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMAIN 6 FEET FROM OTHERS AT ALL TIMES.

Spectators will be limited to 2 per swimmer and can only be in the swim center when their swimmer is swimming. We ask that between races you camp in the gym. There will be no spectator camping in the swim center. Volunteers do not count toward spectator limit if they are actively volunteering at the meet session they are attending.

Social distancing will be recommended in the Swim Center and in the gym. We recommend only swimmers in the current and subsequent next two heats be in the swim center at any time. There will be extra space to camp in the adjacent gym.

No glass containers, tobacco, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the swimming venue.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct and athlete protection provisions will be enforced.

All persons acting in any coaching capacity on deck must be currently registered coach members of USA Swimming and will display their current credentials at all times during the meet. The swimmers must be under the supervision of a USAS member coach during all warmups, competition, and cool downs.

Swimmer, official, and coach registration will be confirmed with Montana Swimming Registration Chairperson prior to the start of the meet.

Swimmers competing at the meet without their regular coach in attendance will be assigned to a coach in attendance at the meet. Swimmers may request to be assigned to a specific coach at registration.

This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

Eligibility

Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming an Montana Swimming for 2022 prior to the entry deadline. There will be no on deck USA Swimming registration available at this meet. Teams entering swimmers who are not currently registered USA swimming athlete members may be fined \$25 per swimmer by the Montana Swimming Registration Chair. All Swimmers including those who qualified for state are invited to enter the BC Meet provided they meet the following criteria:

Any swimmer, ages 9-21 that qualified for Montana Short Course State meet with a BB or faster time since January 1, 2021, are ineligible to enter any events in which they have a B time or faster, they may enter any event in which their best time in any course is a B time or SLOWER in the qualifying period since January1, 2021

Swimmers 8 and Under may enter any event for which they <u>do not</u> have a state qualifying time in any course (SCY, LCM, SCM) since January 1, 2021.

Exception: 8 and Under swimmers may elect to swim either in 8 and Under events OR in 10 and Under events, but not both. 8 and Under swimmers <u>may</u> swim in 10 and Under relays.

Times achieved in a USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed meet or international equivalent, as appropriate, can be used to qualify for the Junior BC Championships. Times earned at a non-sanctioned meet cannot be used to enter the meet.

All individual entry times will be verified through the USA swimming and/or the Montana Swimming times database, as appropriate.

Swimmer's age as of the first day of the meet (March 5, 2022) shall determine the swimmer's age group.

Swimmers with

Disabilities

Montana Swimming and the Bozeman Barracuda Swim Club welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 106, to compete at the meet. Disabled swimmers or their coaches are required to provide advanced notice in writing to the Meet Referee and Meet Director to arrange for any needed accommodations, including personal assistants required and/or registered service animals by the meet entry date. The Meet Referee in his/her sole discretion shall determine whether the needed accommodations can be met by the meet resources. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the Bozeman Barracuda's ability to accommodate all requests.

Entries

Team entries must be submitted by email to <u>meetregistrar@bozemanbarracudas.org</u> using Hy-Tek or Team Unify software by **Wednesday February 23, 2022.** Additionally, team entries should be

accompanied by a meet entry report and the attached team Entry Fee Summary and Waiver/Release form.

Entries from individual USA Swimming athletes without access to Hy-Tek or Team Unify software may be submitted by providing all information identified on the enclosed 'Individual Entry Sheet. This form may be emailed to the registrar by the entry deadline.

Entries should be submitted with the swimmer's actual fastest time in short course yards, long course meters or short course meters (Y-L-S). Converted times will not be accepted.

All relay only swimmers must be listed and pay the per swimmer surcharge. No Deck entries will be allowed. The Entry Summary, Waiver, and USA Swimming Registration Confirmation sheet must be filled out, signed, and returned with the entries and reports. No phone or text message entries will be allowed.

Entry Limits

Each swimmer may compete in a maximum of eight (8) individual events, with a maximum of four (4) individual events per day. They can participate in 1 relay per day. No Time entries will be accepted. There will be no minimum waiting period between races so please take this into account when choosing events. Entries are due by Wednesday February 23rd, 2022. See also Time Trial Section for additional information regarding time trial entries.

Entry Verification An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

Entry Deadline

All entries must be received in Bozeman no later than Wednesday February 23, 2022 @ 11:59 pm.

Entries must be made through the swimmer's club with a team check. Checks can be turned in at the meet if not mailed prior to February 19, 2022.

Unattached swimmers may register by email.

Phone entries will not be accepted.

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Late entry fees: \$40 surcharge, \$10.00 per individual event, \$20 per relay.

Entry fees for the individual entries must be received prior to the start of the meet.

Entry Fees

\$35 surcharge, \$5.00 per individual event, \$10 per relay. Outreach swimmer: \$10. Make checks payable to the 'Montana Swimming" No entries will be accepted without payment of fees.

There will be no refunds.

Seeding

Each swimmer will be seeded according to the session they are registered for and submitted times in short course yards. The confirming time standard for this meet is yards. A Il conforming times will be arranged in time order followed by non-conforming times in long course meters and then short course meters (Y-L-S) Events will then be seeded in normal fashion. Swimmers will be seeded and swum from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated.

No time entries will be accepted.

The 400 IM, and 500 and 1000 Free will be seeded and swum fastest to slowest in mixed gender heats

Relays

Relays will be swum and scored as 10 and under and 11-21 for girls, boys and mixed relays. Official mixed relays must be 2 boys and 2 girls of appropriate age for the relay to score or to enter the time into SWIMS. Non-compliant relays will be marked as exhibition.

Relay entry times may be established by aggregating the individual times of the four swimmers involved. Relays must be entered with a time and swimmer names.

Relay cards must be completed and placed in the relay card box located at the meet director table on the pool deck by 10:30 am (preferred method) or turn as directed by the meet referee

Relay swimmers must swim the race in the order the swimmers are listed on the relay entry card given to the lane timer.

Relay scores will be added to the overall team score. Only one really from each team per age group and gender will be eligible to score. Teams may enter an unlimited number of relays per event

Relay only swimmers may only swim a leg of a relay in which the swimmer's best time is a B time or slower in any course in the qualifying period. Relay only swims must pay the meet surcharge fee. Please designate the relay only swimmers in the entry file.

Relay exception for 8 and under swimmers: 8 and Under swimmers may swim the 10 and Under relay events regardless of which age group they choose to swim in at the meet.

Swimmers / teams who fail to report for a relay event will be scratched without penalty.

Positive Check-in All events including the 500 free and 400 IM and 1000 free will be pre- seeded. We do ask that if you know a swimmer is not participating in an event to let us know. The meet referee will have the authority to reseed any event if appropriate.

Scratches

There will be no Clerk of Course. Heat and Lane assignments will appear in the program. Swimmers will be responsible for taking their position behind the blocks. Swimmers failing to report for their races will be scratched at the blocks. Coaches should report scratches on the scratch sheet or to the Meet Referee prior to the start of the meet each day. There will be no penalty for swimmers who fail to scratch from an event.

Scoring

Relays: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2. Only one relay from each gender/ age from each team will score

Awards

Individual events will be scored, and awards given for 8 and U, 9-10, 1112, 13-14, 15-16 and 17-21, boys and girls in each age group. Relays will be scored, and award given for 10 and under and 11 and over.

Medals will be given for all individual events for 1st thru 8th place and ribbons will be given in all individual events for places 9th thru 16th. Teams shall designate a responsible adult to pick up awards after the meet.

Results Meet results will be posted to the Montana Swimming website at: www.mtswimming.com in addition

to Meet Mobile.

Spirit Banner: A traveling team spirit banner will be awarded to the team showing the best display of team spirit as

determined by the coaches, officials and meet management.

B-C Team Championship

There will be a B-C Champion team award (a traveling banner) given to the team with the top total

team score.

Warm Ups

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. Meet management will post warm up times and schedule to the MT swimming website (http://MTswimming.com) on or before March 3rd, 2022, but

reserves the right to modify warm up times, as appropriate

The Safety Marshal will ensure that all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. During competition the 25 meter pool will be available for continuous warm and cool

down supervised by athlete's coaches.

Swimmers must enter the pool using a three-point entry for warmups except for designated start

lanes and times.

Officials/Timers

To the extent possible, teams are asked to provide certified officials for the meet All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and registrations will be

verified by the MT swimming registration chair. Meet officials will display their current credentials at all times during the meet. Officials training will be allowed. Please contact the meet referee ahead of time if you are interested in training. Officials certified less than one year are encouraged to contact

the meet referee to officiate at this meet.

The officials' meetings will be held in the lifeguard room 15 minutes after the start of warmups on Saturday. On Sunday the meeting shall begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the 1000 free. The meeting will be in the hospitality room. Social distancing will be observed, and masks

will be recommended.

Volunteers

Teams should try to provide timers based the number of swimmers in attendance at the meet from their club. A suggested number of timers from each team will be posted with the warmup schedule. Volunteers do not count toward spectator limit if they are actively volunteering at the meet session

they are attending.

Coaches All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Coach registration will

be verified by the MT Swimming Registration Chair.

A coaches meeting will be held following the last set of warmups for Saturday. Other meetings may be held at the Meet Referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at

least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

Protests All protests should be given to the meet referee.

Hospitality Hospitality will provide coffee, lunch and snacks to all officials and coaches.

Concessions The Bozeman Barracudas will be operating a concession stand during the meet. Concessions will be

in the swim center lobby.

Swim Shop

There will be a swim shop in the swim center to purchase goggles, caps, etc.

Spectators

Spectators will be limited to **two per swimmer** and must **remain in the adjacent gym except when their swimmer is swimming.** Exceptions will be made for those with disabilities. Volunteers do not count toward spectator limit if they are actively volunteering at the meet session they are attending. No spectators will be allowed to camp in the swim center. The West and North sides of the deck (coaches' side and start end) and the bulkhead will be a CLOSED DECK area. It will only be open to coaches, officials and swimmers. The meet will be broadcast live on Facebook Live on our Bozeman Barracudas Public Page. We recommend face coverings and social distancing.
