FACILITY

The Butte YMCA Swim Club is hosting the 2024 MT BYSC Winter meet. This meet is only open to currently registered athlete members of BYSC and the YMCA of the USA.

The meet will be held at the Butte Family YMCA, 2975 Washoe Street, Butte, MT 59701. The elevation of the facility is 5500'. The pool is an eight lane, 25 yard regulation short course pool with nine 6" non-turbulent lane lines and Kiefer starting platforms. There is no warm-up/cool down pool available for this meet.

Directions: Take the Montana Street exit into Butte then turn south onto Montana Street. Continue south (straight) on Montana Street past the Town Pump on the left and the cemeteries on the right. Veer left at the end of the cemeteries onto Hansen Road. Continue south along Hansen Road to the YMCA (copper and gray building on left). You may also drive to the pool from Harrison Avenue. Take the Harrison Avenue (south) exit. From Harrison Avenue, turn west onto Dewey Boulevard and continue past Rowe Road crossing the railroad tracks until reaching Washoe Street. Turn left onto Washoe Street and continue to the YMCA.

Timing will be by an automatic Colorado Timing System with pads at both ends of the pool or three manual times.

The pool is 8 feet deep at the start end and 4 feet deep at the turn end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Montana Masters has certified the pool.

MEET FORMAT

This is an age group timed finals meet. Individual events will be swum as noted on the event list. This is a single session meet. There is no minimum waiting period between events. This meet will be seeded and swum in three lanes.

The meet will be pre-seeded. However, the meet referee reserves the right to reseed events, as appropriate, based on scratches, meet timelines and other factors.

If only a few swimmers are entered into an event, other events may be combined, seeded, and swum together without empty lanes between girls' and boys' events at the meet referee's discretion, but will be scored by gender and age group.

There are no relays for this meet.

SAFETY

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. Butte YMCA Swim Club and Butte Family YMCA agree to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Montana Swimming, the State of Montana, and Silver-Bow County.

The Montana Swimming Safety guidelines are in effect for this meet and will be enforced. Each coach is responsible for informing swimmers of the provisions of the safety code before attending the meet.

For circle swimming during warm-ups and cool downs, swimmers must enter the pool using a three-point entry. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated. Safety marshals will be on deck. No diving is allowed from the turn end of the pool.

RACING STARTS

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Any swimmers who must start in the water shall be listed in a separate document returned with the entries.

RULES

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming and Montana Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated.

The meet referee reserves the right to cancel relays if entries look to exceed the four-hour rule for 12 and under swimmers. The meet referee also reserves the right to change the meet format into a split session meet to comply with the 4-hour rule. Teams will be notified if either option is exercised.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone and drones, is not permitted on the balcony behind the starting blocks, or in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or on deck behind starting blocks.

Operating of a drone, or any flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Deck changing is absolutely prohibited. Swimmers may change into and out of swimsuits in the appropriate men's, women's, or family locker rooms. Swimmers may NOT change in the restroom located on the deck by the hot tub.

Adults and non-athlete members may use the restroom on deck by the hot tub and the family changing room restrooms.

No glass containers, tobacco, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the swimming venue.

All persons acting in any coaching capacity on deck must be currently registered coach members of USA Swimming. Swimmer, official, and coach registration will be confirmed with Montana Swimming Registration Chairperson prior to the start of the meet.

This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

No area of the building should be considered secure. BYSC and the Butte Family YMCA are not responsible for loss or damage of any items.

Medical Supervision: A first aid station is available for athletes participating at the meet. An AED is available in the lobby. Lifeguards are on duty during the meet. Emergency medical services can be activated by a phone call.

Meet registration will be checked with the Montana Swimming Registrar prior to the meet to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. This includes, without limitation, individuals listed on the U.S. Center for SafeSport's Centralized Disciplinary Database, USA Swimming's List of Individuals Permanently Suspended or Ineligible for Membership, USA Swimming's List of Individuals Suspended or Ineligible — as of January 21, 2023, and all adult members (defined by the SafeSport Code for the Olympic and Paralympic Movement as 18 years and Over) of USA Swimming who have not completed athlete protection education as required by the U.S. Center for SafeSport.

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct and athlete protection provisions will be enforced.

ELIGIBILITY

All age group swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc by entry deadline as well as registered with the YMCA of the USA. There will be no on deck USA Swimming registration or YMCA registration available at this meet. Teams (or individuals) entering age group swimmers who are not currently registered USA Swimming athlete members may be fined \$25 per swimmer by the Montana Swimming Registration Chair.

Age as of the first day of the meet shall determine the age group in which the swimmer must compete.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

BYSC welcomes all BYSC swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 106, to compete at the meet. Disabled swimmers must contact the meet referee to arrange for any needed accommodations by February 8, 2024. Please notify the meet referee if the use of personal assistants and/or registered service animals is required. It is at the discretion of the meet referee to determine whether the needed accommodations can be met by the meet resources. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host team's ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES

Entries should be submitted as follows:

Teams should e-mail entries to Susan Huckeby shuckeby@msn.com using Hy-Tek or Team Unify software (preferred method) by February 10, 2024. Along with your meet entry file, include your team meet entry report (relay and individual entries) and team entry fee report from Team Manager or Team Unify (in PDF, word or rich text format). Do not include relay swimmer names

- with your relay entries. Please e-mail all reports. Completed paperwork, signed waiver, team entry report, and entry fees must be received by January 20.
- 2. Individuals (not teams) without access to Hy-Tek or Team Unify software may use the Hy-Tek Lite entry software to enter or may e-mail the entry data directly to the registrar. Hy-Tek Lite entry software may be downloaded for free from the Hy-Tek website. No text messages accepted.

ENTRY LIMITS

Each swimmer may compete in a total of five (3) individual events

ENTRY VERIFICATION

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 72 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES

All Entries must be received by: Friday February 10th, 2024.

Send the individual entries to Susan Huckeby at shuckeby@msn.com. Entry fees for the individual entries must be received prior to the start of the meet. Deck entries will only be allowed at the discretion of the meet referee, will be seeded as exhibition swims, will be charged double the entry fee. **No text messages** will be accepted for entries or entry questions.

ENTRY FEES

An entry fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each swimmer competing in the meet. Entry fees must accompany the entries in US dollars. Entries will not be accepted without payment of entry fees and proper paperwork. Waivers must be signed. There will be no refunds.

SEEDING

Swimmers should enter with their fastest officially recorded time in yards or with a converted LCM or SCM time. No time (NT) entries will be accepted.

Times will be seeded in yards.

Swimmers will be seeded slowest to fastest, as shown on the event list. All events will be scored by age group for both girls and boys. If only a few swimmers are entered into an event, other events may be combined, seeded and swum as one event without an empty lane between girls' and boys' events at the meet referee's discretion, but will be scored by gender and age group.

NOTE: Depending upon the number of entries received, the meet referee reserves the right to change the meet format into a split session meet to comply with the 12 and under 4-hour rule. The meet referee also reserves the right to cancel relays if entries look to exceed the four-hour rule for 12 and under swimmers. Teams will be notified if either option is exercised.

SCRATCHES There will be no clerk of course. Heat and lane assignments will appear in

> the program. Swimmers are responsible for taking their position behind the blocks. Coaches should report scratches on the scratch sheet at the timing table or to the meet referee prior to the start of the meet. There will be no

penalty for swimmers who fail to scratch from an event.

SCORING This meet will not be scored.

AWARDS There are no awards for this meet.

WARM-UPS Warm-ups for the meet will begin no earlier than 12:15 pm. Warm-up times

will be determined after entries have been received.

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The safety marshals will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all

warm-up procedures.

Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries or other appropriate logistical considerations.

Swimmers should enter the pool using a three-point entry for warm-ups. Warm-up schedules will be posted at the Butte YMCA

A positive check-in is not required for any event.

POSITIVE CHECK IN

OFFICIALS and

TIMERS

To the extent possible, teams are asked to provide timers and other certified meet officials.

On deck training time may be available for those wishing to train as an official. Trainees should attend the pre-meet officials' meeting and sign in. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and registrations will be verified by the MT Swimming Registration Chair and officials will be asked to show their membership card at the meet using the USA Swimming app. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Please contact the meet referee to let her know you will be officiating or training at the meet.

The officials meeting time will be announced when warm-up times are determined. The meeting will be in the hospitality room.

BYSC parents will serve as timers for this meet. A signup sheet will be posted at the meet specifying lane assignments.

COACHES All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming.

> Coach registration will be verified with the MT Swimming Registration Chair and coaches will be asked to show their membership card at the meet using the USA Swimming app. There will be a coach meeting Sunday with the

time to be announced. Meet Management requests that at least one coach

representative from each team attend all coaches' meetings.

PROTESTS: All protests should be given to the meet referee.

HOSPITALITY There is no hospitality available.

CONCESSIONS/ SWIM SHOP There will be no concessions for this meet.

MEET PROGRAM The meet program can be purchased on Meet Mobile.

PARKING Parking is available next to the facility and across the street.

SPECTATORS Spectators may be seated in the spectator areas on the bleachers, on the

pool deck, and on the balcony above the start end of the pool. **No spectators and no athletes are allowed in the upstairs weight room area.** No spectators will be allowed along the west wall in the coach seating area. In the coach seating area only meet management, officials, and coaches

may be in this area except athletes who are talking briefly with their coaches and then leave the area. We also ask that parents of 9 and over swimmers not be in the area behind the blocks unless you are timing. Do

not block doorway or entrances.
