#### **FACILITY**

The meet will be held at the Grizzly Pool, which is located next to the Fieldhouse, southwest of the UM Washington Grizzly Football Stadium on the campus of the University of Montana in Missoula. The pool is a seven lane, 25 yard regulation short course pool. The pool is 12 feet deep at the start end and 3.5 feet deep at the turn end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Warm up/cool down lanes are not available.

The timing system is Colorado Timing System 6 with touchpads at both ends of the pool, including three manual backup systems. New Spectrum Xcellerator starting platforms give swimmers exposure to the latest racing advantage. Spectrum back stroke wedges are available to swimmers.

#### **MEET FORMAT**

The First Annual MAC Sprinterfest is an age group meet. The 25 Butterfly, Backstroke and Breaststroke, and Freestyle will Prelims/Semis/Finals for all age groups. The 50 Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke, and Freestyle will be Prelims/Semis/Finals for 9&O swimmers. All other events will be swum as timed finals. All 25-yard events and the 100 IM will be swum as Open; The 200 Fly, 200 Breast, 200 Back, and 400 IM will be 11 and over. The 500 Free, 200 Free, and 200IM will be 9 & over. All events, except where otherwise noted, will be scored and awarded 8 & U, 9 & 10, 11-12, 13 & over. Swimmers must be USA Swimming registered in order to participate.

#### **SAFETY**

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical

conditions are especially vulnerable. USA Swimming, Inc., cannot prevent you (or your child(ren)) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in USA Swimming sanctioned events. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to participate in a USA Swimming sanctioned event, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19. BY ATTENDING OR PARTICIPATING IN THIS COMPETITION, YOU VOLUNTARILY ASSUME ALL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH EXPOSURE TO COVID-19 AND FOREVER RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS USA SWIMMING AND MONTANA SWIMMING AND EACH OF THEIR OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, AGENTS, EMPLOYEES OR OTHER REPRESENTATIVES FROM ANY LIABILITY OR CLAIMS INCLUDING FOR PERSONAL INJURIES, DEATH, DISEASE OR PROPERTY LOSSES, OR ANY OTHER LOSS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CLAIMS OF NEGLIGENCE AND GIVE UP ANY CLAIMS YOU MAY HAVE TO SEEK DAMAGES, WHETHER KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, FORESEEN OR UNFORESEEN, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH. Missoula Aquatic Club agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Montana Swimming, Missoula County, the University of Montana, and the State of Montana. Masks are recommended for all swimmers and spectators.

The Montana Swimming Safety guidelines are in effect for this meet and will be enforced. For circle swimming during warm-ups and cool-downs, swimmers must enter the pool using a three-point entry. Coaches are advised to supervise their swimmers at all times closely. No running or horseplay will be tolerated. A safety marshal will be on deck.

Lifeguards will be on duty on the pool deck throughout the meet and an AED is available in the lifeguard office. The lifeguards and Grizzly Pool employees will be the first to assist in case of an emergency. If there is an emergency the Grizzly Pool staff/lifeguards should be notified immediately.

#### **RACING STARTS**

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

#### **RULES**

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming and Montana Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional, and exceptions are stated.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. **Visual recording devices, including cell phones, are not permitted behind the starting blocks.** Operation of drone, or any flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

No glass containers, tobacco, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the swimming venue. No food is allowed on deck. Food will be allowed in the stands above the deck.

All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct and athlete protection provisions will be enforced. All persons acting in any coaching capacity on deck must be currently registered coach members of USA Swimming.

This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, webcasting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgment and consent to this fact. This is a closed deck meet.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. There will be no deck registration. *Age as of the first day of the meet shall determine the age group in which the swimmer must compete.* 

# SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

MAC welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to compete at the meet. Disabled swimmers or their coaches are required to provide advance notice in writing to the meet referee and meet director to arrange for any needed accommodations including personal assistants required and/or registered service animals by the meet entry date. It is at the discretion of the meet referee to determine whether the needed accommodations can be met by the meet resources. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the Missoula Aquatic Club's ability to accommodate all requests.

#### **ENTRIES**

Entries are to be submitted using one of two methods:

- 1. Teams should e-mail entries to <a href="mailto:jayifriend@gmail.com">jayifriend@gmail.com</a> using Hy-Tek or Team Unify software (preferred method) by February 1, 2025. Along with your meet entry file, include your team meet entry report (relay and individual entries) and team entry fee report from Team Manager or TeamUnify (in PDF, word or rich text format). Do not include relay swimmer names with your relay entries. Please e-mail all reports. Completed paperwork, signed waiver, team entry report, and entry fees must be received by February 1, 2025.
- 2. Individuals (not teams) without access to Hy-Tek or Team Unify software may submit entries on the enclosed master entry sheet. Hy-Tek Lite entry

software may be downloaded for Free from the Hy-Tek website to enter swimmers. Swimmers may also e-mail the entry data to the registrar by February 1, 2025. Entry information must be completely filled out as follows: first and last name age, and sex of swimmer as well as USAS/FINA/USMS registration number of each swimmer along with event and entry time.

3. All relay-only swimmers must be listed and pay the per swimmer surcharge.

#### **ENTRY LIMITS**

Each swimmer may compete in a maximum of 6 individual events; at most 3 each day. Swimmers shall be seeded based on their submitted times. *Entrants shall submit their fastest officially recorded times in either yards or converted meters.* "No time" entries will be accepted. There may be deck entries but only in available lanes.

Entries will close with the team who enters the 300<sup>th</sup> swimmer.

#### **ENTRY VERIFICATION**

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

#### **ENTRY DEADLINES**

The Meet Registrar must receive team entries by the date and time identified below. Late entries may be accepted, but there will be a \$25 late charge. Entries must be received by: February 1, 2025. Mail fees to Mike Fontaine, Missoula Aquatic Club, P.O. Box 7434, Missoula, MT 59807. Phone/e-mail entries for individuals (not teams) will be accepted until January 29, 2025. Send the individual entries to Jay Friend at <a href="mailto:jayifriend@gmail.com">jayifriend@gmail.com</a>. Entry fees for the individual entries must be received prior to the start of the meet. No text messages will be accepted for entries or entry questions.

If the referee accepts late entries, there will be a \$25 fee for late entry fee charged plus double the entry fees for any events entered.
