## FTLL SWIM EQUIPMENT RENTAL OPTIONAL

The Fort Leavenworth Lancers has the option for swimmers to rent their swimming equipment. This agreement is optional for families and the actual contract will be signed at the time the equipment is checked out. See Coach Sarah to sign the actual rental agreement and checkout the needed equipment.

## **EQUIPMENT SUBJECT TO LEASE:**

- Mesh gear bag
- Hand paddles
- Pull bouy
- Fins short, long, crossblade, breaststroke,
- Kickboard

**PAYMENT TERMS**: The Lessee shall make a payment of \$5.00 each calendar month. Payments shall be due no later than the 10th day of each month in conjunction with the monthly fees.

**LEASE TERM:** This Lease shall begin on the above effective date and shall terminate on July 31, 2024, unless the equipment is returned at an earlier date, at which point, payments will stop. Equipment rental continues dues months when the swimmer is inactive/injured.

**MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR**: The Lessee shall maintain, at replacement cost, the equipment in good repair and operating condition, allowing for reasonable wear and tear.

**RETURN OF EQUIPMENT:** At the end of the Lease term or upon leaving the team, the Lessee shall be obligated to return the equipment to the Lessor. Failure to return equipment will result in a charge of the full replacement market price for all items listed above.

**ACCEPTANCE OF EQUIPMENT:** The Lessee shall inspect each item of equipment delivered pursuant to this Lease. The Lessee shall immediately notify the Lessor of any discrepancies between such items of equipment and the description of the equipment in the Equipment Schedule. If the Lessee fails to provide such notice before accepting delivery of the equipment, the Lessee will be conclusively presumed to have accepted the equipment as specified in the Equipment Schedule.

**RISK OF LOSS OR DAMAGE:** The Lessee assumes all risks of loss or damage to the equipment from any cause, and agrees to return it to the Lessor in the condition received from the Lessor, with the exception of normal wear and tear.
