Inclement Weather Policy for Tsunami Swim Team:

Tsunami makes any and all reasonable attempts to make practice available to its members. Some pools may be closed as their operational procedures are tied to their local school district's closures or rules regarding weather. Practices may be moved to other open pools due to facility closures of this nature.

Safe travel conditions must be a priority for everyone. Please use good judgment in considering practice attendance during challenging weather conditions. Tsunami cannot guarantee safe travel during periods of inclement weather.

For spring/summer months, typically the only weather related problem that may prevent us from training outdoors is thunderstorms. If there is a thunderstorm in the immediate area and the coaches deem the situation not safe, we will not put swimmers in the water. However, such storms are usually localized and pass over very quickly.

It should be noted that the Clayview Bubble is grounded so during April & May we are able to swim while there is a thunderstorm. In addition, it could be raining hard with lightning at your house and be perfectly dry and sunny at Clayview or any outdoor pool with which we are practicing. **Consequently, we ask swimmers to always plan on coming to practice, unless cancellations or changes have been communicated via email or sent to your phone - all through our ONDeck app via our team website.**

Note: If you are not receiving emails, you will not receive practice cancellations, as the same system will be used.
