COACHES CORNER Head Coach Nick Baker

First off, I would like to thank everyone for their flexibility regarding our schedule over the past few weeks - it feels good to finally be back home at PLHS! On Tuesday May 30, a parent meeting was held and I wanted to include a summary of the topics discussed in the Coaches Corner: -Bylaws Update: SCSC regularly reviews and revises bylaws based on the current and future needs of the team. The bylaws will be amended to alter the size of the Board to 3 appointed members, as well as fixing some wording that was missed in the previous edit. You will receive a survey regarding the bylaw changes soon.

-North Dakota Meet and Midwestern Championships: As we have been communicating for the past several months, our team's focus meet this summer is the Fargo Meet. As coaches, we feel that this meet gives our swimmers the best opportunity to perform at a high level. Our season plan includes peaking at that time, however we are still in support of any swimmers who choose to attend Midwestern Championships in July and we will continue to make sure swimmers competing at Midwestern Championships perform well.

-Dues Increase: The SCSC Board reviews our due structure annually. Through COVID, we had not regularly increased dues and at that time we did have to make a somewhat substantial increase. In an effort to avoid having a large increase in dues a few years down the road, it was decided to increase swimmer dues by ~2.5%, which is no more than \$3. In addition, our annual registration fee will increase by \$10, and that increase will provide each swimmer with an annual SCSC team t-shirt for the year.

-Master's Swimming and Howling Pack: We plan to begin a Master's Swimming program in August to serve parents of our swimmers as well as adults in our community. The Howling Pack program was recently launched, and is an additional way for families and the community to support SCSC. Information regarding both of these programs can be found on the team website.

DUES & REGISTRATION INCREASE

The SCSC Executive Board voted at their last meeting to increase membership dues by roughly 2.5% beginning August 1, 2023. This increase allows us to be able to continue retaining and recruiting a high-quality coaching staff while providing a competitive salary.

Along with monthly dues increase, the board approved a \$10 increase to the annual registration fee. The \$110 registration (\$100 previous) is also effective August 1, 2023 and will provide all registered swimmers with an annual SCSC t-shirt (different than the black shirt given when joining).

With these dues increases, SCSC still remains one of the most affordable year-round swim teams in the Omaha metro area.
