

All swimmers will participate in this fun team event that is also our biggest fundraiser. **In the past, our team raised \$4772**, **\$4143**, **\$3987**, **and \$4295** in **2015**, **2016**, **2017**, **and 2018 respectively**. With the help of parents, families, coaches and, of course, the Stingrays swimmers, we are looking forward to another successful year. Our goal this year is to raise **\$4500**.

Funds raised from the swimathon are used for a number of key activities of the team including purchase of common use swim equipment, contribution to the YMCA annual campaign (which also funds swim team fees of families in need), fund team activities, awards etc.



Please check with your swimmers for their Swim-a-thon distance goals and help them get fundraising pledges (per lap or lump sum) from families, friends and neighbors. 
