	Respect officials and their judgment and abide by the rules of the event.
	Treat opposing coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.
	Instruct participants in sportsmanship and demand that they display good
	sportsmanship.
	Coach in a positive manner and do not use derogatory comments or abusive
	language.
	Win with humility and lose with dignity.
	Treat every athlete fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently, and with
	sensitivity.
	Always place the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other
	considerations, including developing performance.
	Continue to seek and maintain their own professional development in all
	areas related to coaching and teaching children.
	Always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.
