CONFIDENTIALITY

This form serves as a contractual agreement between athlete, parent, RAH! Elite All-Stars, and RAH! Dance Company. **Upon registration, all parties agree to the following:**

- 1. No athlete or parent shall showcase physically nor digitally/electronically any part of choreography to anyone not affiliated with RAH! Elite All-Stars or RAH! Dance Company.**
- 2. No athlete or parent shall recreate, revamp, revise, nor re-teach any part of any choreography by any RAH! coach or anyone working for RAH! in any way, for personal gain, school squads, or any squad or persons not affiliated with RAH! Elite All-Stars or RAH! Dance Company.**
- 3. The business plan, operations, policies and procedures, administrative aspects, financial status, coaching staff, and athlete status shall NOT be discussed verbally, digitally or written with anyone not affiliated with RAH! Elite All-Stars or RAH! Dance Company.**
- 4. All business of the RAH! Elite All-Stars and RAH! Dance Company family shall stay inside the RAH! family.**
- 5. All personal business of any member of RAH! Elite All-Stars and RAH! Dance Company, which includes athletes, parents, staff and coaches shall NOT be discussed under any circumstances.**

agree to abide by the rules of this contract and I understand that my violation of this agreement will result in immediate dismissal of my athlete from RAH! Elite All-Stars/RAH! Dance Company. I am in full understanding that if violation of Rule #3 occurs, I could be subject to legal action under the sole discretion of the owners of RAH! Elite All-Stars and RAH! Dance Company. In the event of dismissal, all merchandise of RAH! Elite All-Stars and RAH! Dance Company must be returned **ONLY IF** the items were purchased by the company and the separation clause **WILL** apply.

AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.***

FEES FOR THE SEASON:

Registration	\$125 for all RAH! Athletes
Tuition	3-6 yr olds \$65. 7-11 yr olds \$95. 12-18 yr olds \$75. This includes two 1-2 hour practices with mandatory tumbling once a month & mandatory routine refresh once a month. There is a \$10 discount for the first sibling and \$15 for third, fourth etc. There is a 47.5% discount for athletes that cross programs. Pay full season tuition up front and receive a 10% discount off your total! (Discount only applies to tuition portion of the monthly fee).

FUNDRAISING:

- We will fund raise to offset as much of the expenses as possible!
 - It is not mandatory to participate in fundraisers however, if you choose **NOT** to participate, **NO** grace periods or extra time will be given to pay **any** fees.
- Fundraisers for the gym will occur and ARE mandatory! Athletes are expected to participate in gym fundraisers as the improvement of the gym is a direct benefit of the athlete.
- We welcome suggestions, as well as feedback on fund raising opportunities!

PAYMENT:

- Payment is expected on the **1st** of every month. Fees are not prorated for any missed time or less practices in a month. If payment is not received by the **5th** of the month, a ***\$30 late fee will be added on the 6th.*** Accepted payment methods are as follows: cash, and credit/debit card via the website. If payment is not received by the **10th** of the month, your athlete will be suspended until the account is brought current. If late payments after the 10th become a reoccurring problem, the athlete will be dismissed from the program with no refunds and the separation clause will apply.
- In order for apparel and accessories to be ordered on time, payments must be made **ON TIME**. If your payment is not received before order is placed, your items will not be ordered with everyone else's. Any orders placed outside of group order will have shipping and other fees added that are accrued from being under the order limits.

SEPARATION CLAUSE:

- If for **any** reason an athlete separates from RAH! Cheer & Dance, LLC (RAH! Elite All-Stars/RAH! Dance Company) and no longer wishes to continue in any program, a separation fee will be required. The separation fee will be equal to ***\$250 PER ATHLETE PLUS any past due fees*** paid via debit/credit card listed on the account. **There will not be a refund of any paid monies.** Any RAH! apparel purchased by the parent/guardian may be sold to current athletes or back to the company at a reduced price. If separation occurs before apparel arrives, the apparel will be sold to a current athlete or by the company and the parent/guardian will be provided those funds at cost if sold and IF there is no past due balance.

TIME COMMITMENT

COMMUNITY SERVICE:

- There will be community service events that ALL RAH! members will participate in. Exposing our athletes to the service of others is very important to the owners of the company. We are not just training great athletes, we are building exceptional young people. Examples are feeding the needy, collection of items to donate to the needy, visiting the elderly, working events, etc.

PERFORMANCES:

- RAH! athletes will participate in performances for events throughout the season. Examples are college basketball games, parades, community events, etc.

PRACTICES:

- Competitive teams will have two 1hour-2 hour practices a week plus monthly tumbling. Attendance is **MANDATORY!** It is imperative that everyone is present at practice and tumbling to maximize growth and skill level improvements. Absences should only occur when ***absolutely unavoidable!*** Please communicate effectively when tardiness and/or absences must occur.
- **ALL** training must be done through RAH! and JOGG Cheer. No outside training is allowed unless approved by coaching staff. We train through proper progressions and strength and conditioning and it is important that training is consistent.
- Excessive absences will result in dismissal from the team. It is very difficult to have an effective practice if everyone is not present **and ON TIME.**
- ***Choreography camp is MANDATORY!***
- There will be monthly Routine Refresh camps starting in October. These are **MANDATORY** as well.
- ***Performances are MANDATORY!***
- **NO unexcused absences are allowed the week of competition!**
- Tardiness is very disruptive to practice and hinders the success of the team!
- **Birthdays ARE NOT accepted as an excuse to miss practice, events, competitions or performances!**
- **INJURIES:** If an injury should occur, it is the responsibility of the parent to seek professional help if necessary. Each athlete must have his/her own medical insurance. After seeking a physician, please provide your coach with an evaluation of the athlete's injury and status. A release from a doctor is required if a serious injury should occur. If an injury prevents the student from continuing, there will be no refunds. Monies will be used for a replacement.

ALLOWED absences:

- 3 excused/unexpected personal absences
- 2 unexcused absences

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***Any absences after the above list will result in dismissal from the program. No refund will be given, and the Separation Clause will apply.**

***We believe in a healthy balance between the importance of family time and the needs of the program. We will have the week of July 4th off. When possible, take advantage of the summer break during this week for your family vacations.**

COMPETITIONS:

- Starting in January, there will be *at least* 1 competition per month through April.
- Attendance at **ALL** competitions is **MANDATORY!** The only exception to this rule is contagious sickness.

***Arriving ON TIME is essential and expected for ALL events, practices, appearances, and competitions!**

***Being late to a competition will result is a fine of \$50. After the 3rd tardy, the athlete will be dismissed from the program.**

PRACTICE & PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

PRACTICE WEAR:

- Until official practice wear is received, **ALL BLACK FITTED ATHLETIC ATTIRE & ANY COLOR ATHLETIC SHOES** are required! This is for the safety of the athlete.
- Once official practice wear is received, it is expected of every athlete to be in official practice wear or RAH! apparel for **ALL** practices.
- There will be designated practices where special attire is acceptable (i.e., pink for breast cancer awareness, tacky day, crazy sock day, etc.).
- **NO JEWELRY** is to be worn during practice or events! This is for the safety of the athletes and coaches. It is a **RULE** for competitions and will cause deductions from our score if not followed.
- **Nails must be SPORT LENGTH!** The nail must not go over the fingertip. This is for the safety of the athletes. **NO COLOR** on nails for competitions/events unless otherwise specified.

PERFORMANCE ATTIRE:

- The owners and coaches will notify parents and athletes of what to wear for performances. Athletes are expected to arrive fully dressed according to instructions given. If athlete is without any items, they will have to borrow from another athlete. This should not be a reoccurring problem.
- Attire for competitions will always include: Full uniform, cheer socks, cheer shoes, hair piece, and make up. If anything else is needed/not needed, the owners and coaches will notify parent and athlete ahead of time.

***Appearance is always expected to be TOP NOTCH! The "look" will be explained thoroughly before the first performance and expected to be executed to perfection there after.**

BEHAVIOR

***Athletes, parents and family/supporters are expected to act with class at all times. No one is to speak on the behalf of RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company except the owners, and coaches of the company.**

RULES OF THE GYM:

- Practices are closed. Parents, guardian, and family are allowed inside the gym **only** to drop off/pick up athletes, for meetings, to use the rest room and at the request of the owner or coaches. Parents, friends and family are welcome to stay in their cars or drop their athlete off and leave the premises. When a parent room is available, you are more than welcome to use it.
- Athletes must be picked up **ON TIME!** A late fee will be applied for excessive late pick-ups.
- Everyone that enters the RAH! training facility is expected to treat the staff and the facility with the utmost respect at all times.
- Do your best not to leave your belongings in the facility. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Throw away trash, place recyclable items in the recycle bins when available, keep belongings tidy in designated area and keep all areas clean.
- **NO NEGATIVE ATTITUDES ALLOWED!**
- The gym is not a playground. Practice time is for learning and perfecting skills needed to successfully compete as a competitive athlete.
- Athletes are expected to listen to and respect their coaches at all times.

PERMISSION TO PHOTOGRAPH/VIDEO

RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company will take photos and video of your athlete during practices, events, performances, appearances, and competitions (when allowed by the event producer) etc. These images and footage will be used for promotion of RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company and all of its entities. The following agreement gives permission to photograph and video your athlete:

Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company has my permission to use those images and footage for promotional purposes of RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company.

If one does NOT give permission to photograph and video of their child, a denial form can be requested and signed digitally or physically.

COMMUNICATION

***EFFECTIVE communication is VERY important to the success of this program. The owners and coaches will be as clear and concise as possible when relaying information to the parent/guardian of the athletes.**

- Band App will be the **MAIN** form of communication. It is imperative that you check your groups every day, multiple times a day! Posts will normally be made at the beginning and end of the day. Please download the Band App so you are able to receive messages quickly and effectively. **PLEASE TURN NOTIFICATIONS ON!**
- Emails, text messages, and phone calls are secondary forms of communication. These methods are used when information needs to reach you quickly or there is a LOT of information to be given!
- If you will be tardy, absent, or have an emergency, the first point of contact is your athlete's coach/es! If for some reason you cannot reach the coach/es. Exhaust **ALL** options of communication!
- Do not put personal situations in the Band App or other group messengers unless given permission by the owners. You may send a direct message to Coach Rah Rah or Coach T through Band or text whenever necessary.

***When in doubt, ASK! Even if you think you SHOULD know the answer, still ask!
Effective communication is KEY to success!**

PARENT CONTRACT

Upon registration, all parties agree to the following:

- _____ I understand that by trying out and paying \$125 registration and \$95/\$75/\$65 Tuition that I am committing to being on a team. If I decide that me/my athlete will not be committing to the team within 30 days after evaluations that I forfeit my \$125 registration fee as well any other payments.
- _____ I understand that all competition fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**.
- _____ I fully understand the financial commitment and consequences of late payments and agree to pay all fees on time.
- _____ I understand the absence policy and if an athlete exceeds the number of absences, they will be dismissed from the team. No refunds and the Separation Clause would apply.
- _____ I understand that Competitive Cheer & Dance are team sports and that a practice should not be taken away from the athlete as a consequence for bad behavior at home or at school.
- _____ I understand the absence and tardy policy and will adhere to it the entire season.
- _____ I will encourage my athlete to be humble in victory and graceful in defeat!
- _____ I understand that Choreography Camp is **MANDATORY**. No exceptions.
- _____ I understand that the coaching staff has the right to close or open practices as they deem necessary.
- _____ I understand that an athlete **CANNOT** miss any competitions or events or will be dismissed from the team unless contagious or serious illness/injury occurs.
- _____ I understand the importance of being a positive role model for all athletes. **GOSSIPING**, spreading negativity in or out of our facility or on social media will not be tolerated and we reserve the right to remove immediately any athlete/parent from the program violating this policy.
- _____ I will respect the coaches and their authority during practices and competitions and will not question, discuss or confront the coaches during a practice, competition or event, nor will I pull my child out of practice, competition, or event without communicating with the coach. I will take the time to speak with the coaches at an agreed upon time and place. This includes “venting” or being disrespectful on any form of social media.
- _____ I understand that “Good Sportsmanship” will be practiced at **ALL** times while representing RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company **EVERY** athlete **AND** parent is expected to be a good ambassador of our program.
- _____ I understand if an athlete leaves or is dismissed from the program prior to completion of the season, payments are non-refundable. The Separation Clause would apply and a charge of \$250 will incur.
- _____ I will attend parent meetings, read e-mails, and check group messengers or any other form of communication to receive information.

2.0 In consideration of the Participant being permitted to participate in the Activity, we do release, waive, forever discharge, and hereby covenant not to sue RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company, its governing board, officers, agents, employees and volunteers acting as Hosts from and against any and all liability for any harm, injury, damage, claims, demands, actions, causes of action, costs and expenses of any nature which Participant may have or which may hereafter accrue to Participant, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including but not limited to suffering and death, that may be sustained by Participant or his/her property, whether caused by the negligence or carelessness of RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company or otherwise, while Participant is in transit to and from the facility and engaged in the Activity. Participant agrees that s/he will not leave the facility without the prior approval of designated officials at the facility, will remain in the presence of the Host at all times and abide by any other regulations provided by the Host or company including, but not limited to, the company's policy of no drugs, no alcohol, and no weapons on the premises.

3.0 I/We have signed this Release in full recognition and appreciation of the potential dangers, hazards and risks inherent to cheerleading and dance and associated activities thereto.

4.0 I/We understand and agree that RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company does not have medical personnel or treatment available to Participant on the premises. I/We hereby authorize and grant full permission for the Company to secure emergency medical treatment for Participant, if necessary, and further that such action shall be subject to the terms of this Agreement. We understand and agree that the Company makes no warranty and assumes no responsibility for any injury or damage that might arise out of or in connection with such authorized emergency medical

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treatment. We further state that there are no health-related problems or reasons that would preclude or restrict the Participant's participation in this Activity, and that Participant is covered by adequate medical health insurance to provide for any medical costs that may be necessary during the Activity.

5.0 It is my/our express intent that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement shall bind the members of Participant's family and spouse, estate, heirs, personal representatives, or assignees, as applicable, and shall be deemed as a "Release, Waiver, Discharge and Covenant Not to Sue" **RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company**. Participant's Parent/Guardian further agrees to save and hold harmless, indemnify and defend **RAH! Elite All-Stars & RAH! Dance Company** from any claim by Participant or Participant's family arising out of Participant's participation in the activity described above.

7.0 I/We further agree that if any term or provision of this Release shall be held illegal, unenforceable or in conflict with any law governing this Release, the validity of the remaining portions shall not be affected thereby.

8.0 I/We understand that the novel coronavirus (COVID- 19) respiratory infection have been confirmed throughout the United States, including several cases in North Carolina. In accordance with the most recent guidance and protocols issued by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services for slowing transmission of COVID-19, I understand that RAH! Elite All-stars; RAH! Dance Company has put in place, preventive measures to reduce the spread of COVID -19; however, RAH! Elite All-Stars; RAH! Dance Company cannot guarantee that I or my child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19.
