Introductions

Hyslop Pool Update

- We have confirmed use through 2018
- We have received an additional increase in rent to \$23,000 per year
- Raising dues \$10 per group per swimmer per month – starting 11/1, billing 12/1
- Increase booster fees to \$300 per season for short course, and \$200 for long course
 - Ultimately our goal is to make \$0 from fees – we truly need parent support to allow the team to run – we are completely volunteer outside of our coaching staff
- Senior group at the Hyslop all year
 - We will not be using Red River this year because of the additional availability of the Hyslop now that UND does not have a swimming/diving program
- **Hosting state in March – Short Course 2018**
 - **Volunteer requirements will be great – will be easy to work through booster fees**
- Going forward we will be offloading some of the accounting processes to an accountant – Donna Reemer

Coach Update

- Bryan Walls - 20th year coaching
 - Less time on deck during fall – we instead promoted Chelsea to Head Age Group Coach, allowing her to take lead on deck when Bryan is not in house
 - Successful fall – 29 new swimmers on the team after close of stroke clinic

- Practice meet early during the 2nd week of November
 - Help the kids get ready for meet protocol
