	rooms. Per NI policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.		
	Deck changes are prohibited.		
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. 		
	• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.		
	Dive-over starts will be used.		
	• The Meet Director and the NI Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.		
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.		
	The swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine the age for the entire meet.		
	• Individual swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events for the meet.		
	The meet director reserves the right to limit entries in any event to run the meet within the time allocated.		
	Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	• Events #19 & #20 - 500 Freestyle will require positive check in by the end of the warmup period.		
WARM-UP	The prescribed NI warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.		
	• Lane assignments for the warmup period will be communicated to the coaches in advance of the meet.		
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.		
	Swimmers must remain in designated areas of the building		
SEEDING	All events will be pre-seeded, slow to fast except for the 500 Freestyle which will be deck seeded, fast to slow after the positive check-in period has ended.		
SCORING	The meet will not be scored		
AWARDS	No awards will be given at this meet		
PROGRAMS	Programs will be available online and heat sheets and unofficial results will be posted to Meet Mobile.		
CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times. 		
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	Admission charge of \$3.00 will be charged for all spectators 10 & over.

	Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede the session during warm-ups.		

TIMERS	The host team will provide timers for all events except the 500 Freestyle. Swimmers will be responsible for providing their own timer and counter for the 500 Freestyle.		
ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to baac.meets@gmail.com.		
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2023 BAAC Holiday Meet". If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.		
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.		
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).		
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.		
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	 The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director. 		
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by NI and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
