• New/Old Business (Lucas)

- Welcome to Ann Marie Peterson, new Publicity Coordinator. Ann Marie has one son on the team.
- Welcome to Keri Giordano, new Volunteer Coordinator. Keri has two children on the team.
- All PAC members were asked to review PAC Guidelines. There will be a
 two-term limit per family and continued updates to guideline language to
 ensure that the PAC and its efforts remain in line with what is important to
 swimmers and their families.
- We may need to revisit Strong Kids Campaign contributions from Swim a Thon as team grows.

• Parent Meetings (B. Peterson)

- We want to make sure that all parents/families feel connected to the team.
- Parents will be invited to informational meetings from September-March.
 Possible topics include nutrition, managing swimmer stress/anxiety at meets, and dryland exercises to build strength outside of the pool.
- O These meetings will not only be informational but will help parents get to know each other.

• Coaches Update (Myers)

- Long Course season is going well and the larger number of meets this season has been well received.
- Long Course Nationals are in Greensboro, NC from July 25-29. Coaches Meg and Ryan are attending along with relay swimmers.
- o Spring National Swimmers each received a \$250 stipend funded by PAC.
- o Fall Registration to be sent out shortly.
- Parents were asked for feedback in end of season survey. Feedback was good and suggestions will be implemented but it's a work in progress including lane space issues.
- Purchase of second Go Pro was approved. Coaches will use this to video older swimmers and will offer short sessions to review feedback with individual swimmers and their parents.

• Treasurer's Report (Ouellette)

- Review of financials. Swim a Thon and Banquet are the two biggest fundraisers.
- o The Devilfish PAC balance continue to rise
- o Purchases over \$1000 require YMCA approval.
- O Still waiting for Kix & Stix check from Spirit Wear sale.

• Standing Committee Reports

- Social (Goodman (Sahm))
 - River & Rail, Garwood Lanes, Ashbrook Golf Course, and Stagehouse are being considered for Fall Parent Social. River & Rail is the top contender with a date of September 29, 2023. The hope is to make the parent social more interactive. We usually have between 55-60 parents attend.
 - Bagel Bash date will be set shortly. Coach G will design a shirt for the event that will be sold as a fundraiser.
 - Tentative holiday party date is December 16, 2023.
 - Season end party will again be held at Shackamaxon on April 21, 2024.
- o Timing System (Kapuscinski)
 - AC unit is ready to be installed in timing booth.
 - Working on securing additional parents to help run Meet Manager.
- Fundraising (Crall)
 - Long course Friday bagel sales have raised approximately \$250.
 - The bagels remain very popular and are appreciated by the swimmers.
- o Apparel (Bregman (Young))
 - Devilfish apparel sale will begin in September once new swimmers are added to Team Unify.
 - Team gift will be a sweatshirt in a different color than last year.
 - Purchasing additional caps will be an option.
- o Publicity (A. Peterson)
 - Coach Fred's recaps are so helpful and will find a way to share on social media.
 - Working on updated list of media contacts.
 - Pictures are so important for media articles.
- o Officials (Tao)
 - Swim Officials Level I training to be held at FSPY on September 16, 2023.
 - Swim Officials Level II to be hosted at Westfield Y on September 23, 2023.
 - Do a walk through with officials on meet responsibilities.
- Meet Coordinator (Manahan)
 - The Devilfish Classic 2023 will be held on October 21-22.
 - Planning is already well-underway and there have been lots of meetings with Meg to date to ensure another successful DFC.
 - 8 and under swimmers will have their own session.

- There will be lots of reminders sent about the meet outlining volunteer expectations. Parents can volunteer at sessions other than the one their child is swimming in.
- o Travel (Matera)
 - Hotels for Long Island are booked and they are next door to each other.
 - Silver and States hotels remain the same.
- Volunteer (Giordano)
 - There will be a lot of outreach to all swimmers (and families) this year.
 - Courtney Ouellette will onboard new families to the team.
 - Each practice group will be assigned two team parents that will work like PTO class parents.
