• Coaches Update (Myers)

- Two new State Qualifying Times were earned this weekend, along with 9
 Silver Qualifying Times, 29 Bronze Qualifying Times, and 13 Long Island
 Holiday Meet Qualifying Times.
- o Little kids did great with their first dual meets.
- o 78 percent of kids had best times during weekend meets.
- o Thank you to the older swimmers who helped at Dual Meets and Bagel Bash.
- o Lots of teams and kids are coming to this weekend's Devilfish Classic.
- New York teams are accepted first on October 23 for the Long Island Holiday Meet. On October 24, other teams are accepted. We sent in a preliminary file to get in the meet queue. Entries will be updated after DFC and Autumn Challenge. The last chance to qualify for Long Island will most likely be Autumn Challenge. Long Island is a pre-seeded meet.
