

STAR Meet Volunteer Job Description

Covid Marshall

→ At least two volunteers, 18+

JOB START TIME: 15 minutes prior to “health check” time stated in meet packet

JOB END TIME: end of session

DESCRIPTION:

1) Upon arrival, please grab a Marshall vest from meet cabinet, in a green Rubbermaid tub. Pick up digital thermometers and athlete sign-in sheets from TJ’s office.

2) Set up tables at entrance to building, next to the security desk. Identify one station for spectators and one or two stations for athletes.

3) As people arrive:

→ Coaches, officials and STAR meet volunteers can be directed through the double doors to the Check In table for their temp check and sign in.

→ Swimmers: check temp and have them sign in on sheet provided. Direct athlete to pool area.

→ Spectators: check temp and have them sign in next to their swimmer’s name (spectators limited per description in meet packet). Direct spectators upstairs to bleachers.

4) Once warm-up is underway (most athletes are checked in) through the end of the meet, Covid Marshalls will take turns periodically patrolling the spectator area and pool deck, monitoring for social distancing, mask use and other health related expectations.
