Entry Limit: UIL and National Federation Rules will govern the meet. Each individual athlete may compete in a maximum of four (4) events; no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. Teams are limited to four (4) individual entries per event and two (2) relay entries per event.

Swimming Entries Deadline: Swimming entries are due by 5pm, Monday, December 2nd. Entries should be submitted electronically from Team Manager for teams with 10 or more swimmers to **coachbrian@marswim.org**. Teams with less than 10 swimmers and no access to Team Manager may submit their entries in writing using the attached entry forms. Electronic entries are strongly preferred. Please send a hard copy of your entries (word or pdf) with your electronic entry file.

Diving Entries: Each diver will list (11) eleven dives on the diving sheets. The 1-Meter competition shall consist of five voluntary dives and six optional dives. Dive sheets must be entered on clean entries: www.cleanentries.com by 5:00pm, Monday, December 2nd. Dive changes may be made until one hour prior to the start of the diving competition. Psych Sheet: A psych sheet will be sent by 5:00pm Tuesday, December 3rd.

Eligibility: The coach of each participating school must be a member, in good standing, of the Texas Interscholastic Swimming Coaches Association.

Meet Format: The meet will run in the standard NFHS event order. We will take a 15 min break after the 50FR. There are no time standards for this meet except for the 500FR. (Girls & Boys - 8:00). **We will offer A and B finals (top 16) on Saturday.**

Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$15 per athlete (including relay only swimmers) listed on the team's submitted Hy-tek roster. There are no entry fees for relays. Fees must be received prior to the start of competition. Checks should be made payable to: **MARS**

The lane outside of the competition pool will remain open at all times during the competition for general warm-up/warm-down. NO DIVING IN WARM-UP/WARM-DOWN lanes.

Scoring: Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay Events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Awards: Team awards will be given for the Champion Girls and Boys Teams. Individual medals will be awarded in each event for First through Third place for both Girls and Boys. Medals should be picked up by each coach prior to leaving the meet after finals. Trophies will be awarded at the end of the meet.

This meet may be approved for observation by USA Swimming for NTV purposes. Only times achieved by swimmers who are currently registered with USA Swimming, have an accurate and complete USA Swimming ID number in the meet database, and conform to the technical rules of USA Swimming will be loaded in the SWIMS Database. The athlete's USA Swimming ID must be included in your entry file.
