System and scoreboard and one eight lane warm-up pool. Ample seating and dressing space provided. During the swim portion of the meet eight (8) 25-yard lanes will be available for

continuous warm-up and cool down.

Directions: Loos Natatorium is located on Spring Valley Road between Midway and Marsh Lanes. It is

located less than two miles west of the Spring Valley exit off the North Dallas Tollway. It's approximately two miles north of the Marsh Lane and Midway exits off of I-635 (LBJ).

Warm Up: General warm-up will be conducted in both deep and shallow ends. During the general warm-up

session *circle swimming only*. No sprinting or pace work will be allowed during the general warm-up session. NO DIVING will be allowed from the blocks or the edge of the pool during the

general or team assigned warm-ups. Swimmers shall enter the pool feet first in a cautious manner.

The Team Assigned Warm-Up Schedule will be published by Tuesday, January 14th, 2025.

Pace & Dive Starts: 11:30 to 11:45am PUSH PACE RACING STARTS GENERAL WARM-UP

(Competition Pool) Lanes 1 & 8 Lanes 2, 3, 6 & 7 Lanes 4 & 5

Push pace lanes: Push off one or two lengths from starting end. Circle swimming only.

NO DIVING.

Racing starts: Sprint lanes for racing starts from blocks or for backstroke starts in specified lanes at designated times. Swim one direction and exit the pool at the far end in the same specified lane.

The shallow end pool will remain open for general warmup during Pace & Dive Starts and during the meet. NO DIVING

Rules:

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas and shaving in the facility are violations of NFHS Sportsmanship Rules and will result in disqualification from the meet.

All spectators must remain in the seating area. No chairs are allowed in the spectator bleacher area except for "stadium seats." No standing along the railing will be allowed.

The use of audio or visual recording devices including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms or in the starting area (behind the starting blocks.)

Departures from the normal swimming uniform based on religious beliefs are permitted.

Any other departures from normal swimming uniform; i.e. sports bras, insulin pumps, etc.; must have written authorization from the UIL office in Austin.

Swimmers with Disabilities

Coaches and/or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Referee of any disability prior to the competition.

Taping of any kind is only permitted with submission of a letter from 1) a licensed MD, 2) a licensed registered nurse, 3) a licensed chiropractor or 4) a licensed team trainer. The meet referee still has final say as to whether an athlete will be allowed to compete with tape even with a letter from one of these sources. It is the responsibility of the coach or swimmer to submit these documents to the referee prior to the start of the swim meet.

Entries:

Per Rule 3: Team Personnel; Section 1: Entries by Teams; Art. 1... In championship meets, each team will be permitted a maximum of four (4) entries in an individual event and one (1) team in a relay event.

Per Rule 3: Team Personnel; Section 2: Entries by Individuals; Art. 1...A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. i.e. A competitor shall be permitted to enter up to two (2) individual events and two (2) relays; or a competitor shall be permitted to enter up to three (3) relays and only one (1) individual event.

All seed times <u>MUST</u> be submitted to the 100th of a second. If a competitor does not have a previous time in an event, enter that competitor's time as "NT" (No Time).

Relay Cards will be provided in your team packet when you check-in your team. **Relay cards are due back to Meet Administration by 10:00am.** They will be returned to you at the Coaches' Meeting in Hospitality at 11:45am. Have your athletes bring them directly to their assigned heat and lane and give to one of the timers in their lane

Per Rule 3: Team Personnel; Section 2: Entries by Individuals; Art. 3 "In each relay event, eight individuals may be designated...;" i.e. you may enter only eight (8) swimmers per relay; four (4) primary and four (4) alternates].

Any changes in relay order must be reported to the Meet Referee or his/her representative before the start of each relay event.

Entry Deadline:

All team entries will be submitted via e-mail by Noon on Monday, January 6, 2025 to: annlang12@gmail.com. **Remember** Divers must be included with the team's entries that are due by Noon, Monday, January 6th, 2025. Entries by Team Manager File or UIL Entry Forms (see attached) will only be accepted. When using the Team Manager file please include a pdf copy of your team's entries by name for both individual and relay events. Once your entries are received there will be NO changes to them permitted unless it is a relay order. Ensure that your entries, especially hard copy UIL Entry Forms are complete and correct. We will not accept entries

or corrections after the Monday, January 6th, Noon deadline. <u>THERE WILL BE NO</u> EXCEPTIONS ALLOWED OR LEEWAY GIVEN.

If you have USA Swimming swimmers on your team desiring to be observed for inclusion of their times in the USA Swimming SWIMS Database, please make sure that you include their proper name and correct USA Swimming ID# in your entries.

For divers, make sure to email each of your diver's names and their individual dive lists.

Awards Scoring:

Team Trophies will be awarded to Boy's and Girl's 1st-3rd place.

Medals shall be awarded for 1st - 3rd place for individual and relay events.

Points will be awarded as follows: Individual events: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 Relay Events: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Championship Certificates for

- o Girl and Boy Diver of the Meet (determined by coach's vote)
- Girl's and Boy's Diving Coach of the Year (votes due to the scorer's table before the end of diving)
- o Girl and Boy Swimmer of the Meet (determined by individual event power points)
- o Girl's and Boy's Swimming Coach of the Year (votes due to scorer's table before 100 breast)

The following criteria will be followed to determine TISCA Awards:

- Coaches must be current members of TISCA to be eligible to vote or receive a TISCA
 District Coach of the Year Award. Each TISCA member will get one vote.
- Coach of the Year Award will be determined by a vote of the eligible coaches. Coaches will vote for a Girl's District Coach of the Year and a Boy's District Coach of the Year for both Swimming and Diving.
- TISCA Athlete of the Meet for girls and boys swimming will be determined by utilizing the NISCA power point system. The swimmer(s) with the highest individual point total will be named the Athlete of the Meet for swimming.

Officials:

The uniform for Thursday's timed finals will be white polo shirt over khaki shorts/pants/skirt, as appropriate; white deck shoes.

- This meet will follow NFHS Championship Protocols any swimmer "no showing" for an event will be disqualified from the remainder of the meet.
- Swimmers may submit a Declared False Start prior to the start of an event to avoid swimming that event but that DFS will count as an individual swim.

USA Swimming *Observation:*

This meet will be USA Swimming observed. *Please make sure that any swimmer wanting their swim to be observed has their USA swimming ID number entered correctly.* The host will **not** add them manually.

Weather:
