Medals will be awarded to first, second, and third place in each individual and relay event. Ribbons will be awarded to fourth, fifth, and sixth place in each individual and relay event.

Entries: Each contestant may enter a maximum of four (4) events.

No more than two (2) may be individual events (diving counts as an individual event).

Each team may enter four (4) individuals and one (1) relay in each event.

All Swimming and Diving entries (including dive sheets) will be due to Coach Howard on Friday, January 17, 2025 by 9:00AM. Coach Howard will then send each coach an entry report for his or her team only. Coaches will have until 9:00AM Saturday, January 18, 2025 to make any changes. After 9:00 AM on 1/18/25, entries are final and only scratches will be accepted. Scratches received after the deadline will be considered a DFS in prelims and will count toward the athlete's maximum number of entries.

Psych sheets will be emailed by 5:00PM on 1/18/25.

The meet will be a USA Swimming Observed Meet. Coaches wishing to have their swimmers observed for USA Swimming **MUST** have their USA Swimming ID number

included in the Hy-Tek Team Manager entries upon submission

This meet will be approved for observation by USA Swimming for NTV purposes. Only times achieved by swimmers who are currently registered with USA Swimming, have an

accurate and complete USA Swimming ID Number in the Meet Manager Database, correct spelling of name, and conform to the technical rules will be loaded into the SWMS Database. The athlete's USA swimming ID must be included in your entry file. The meet

host will not add them manually.

This means you must have the swimmer's USAS # & DOB on the District Meet entry file you submit to the District Meet Director.

All USA Swimming athletes 18 years of age and older must have completed the USAS Athlete Protection Training in order for their times to be loaded into the SWMS database.

TISCA District Awards 2024-2025

According to TISCA By-Laws, the following rules are in effect for the District Championships.

The following TISCA Awards will be given at the District Championships.

Girls District Athlete of the Meet – Diving Girls District Athlete of the Meet – Swimming

Boys District Athlete of the Meet – Diving Boys District Athlete of the Meet – Swimming

Girls District Coach of the Year – Diving Girls District Coach of the Year – Swimming

Boys District coach of the Year – Diving Boys District Coach of the Year – Swimming

The following criteria will be followed in determining the TISCA Awards:

- 1. Coaches must be current members of TISCA to be eligible to vote or receive a TISCA District Coach of the Year Award. Each TISCA member will get one vote.
- 2. Coach of the Year Award will be determined by a vote of eligible coaches. Coaches will vote for a Girls Division coach of the Year and a Boys Division Coach of the Year for both Swimming and Diving.
- 3. TISCA Athlete of the Meet for Girls and Boys Swimming will be determined using NISCA Power Points. The swimmer with the highest total will be named the Athlete of the Meet for Swimming.
- 4. TISCA Athlete of the Meet for Girls and Boys Diving will be determined using NISCA Power Points. The diver with the highest total will be named the Athlete of the Meet for Diving.
