**Timers:** Each team will provide timers for the swimming competition portion of this event.

Warm Up: The first half hour will be a general warm up in all lanes. General warm up lanes: NO DIVING. Circle

swimming only. No sprinting or pace work will be allowed during the general warm up session. NO DIVING will be allowed from the blocks or the edge of the pool. Swimmers shall enter the pool feet

first in a cautious manner.

The last 15 minutes of warm up per lane will be:

PUSH PACE RACING STARTS GENERAL WARM UP 1 & 8 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 Warm pool

Push pace lanes: Push off one or two lengths from starting end. Circle swimming only. NO DIVING. Racing starts: Sprint lanes for racing starts from blocks or for backstroke starts in specified lanes at designated times. Swim one direction only and exit the pool on the opposite end in the same

specified lane.

Swimmers w/ Coaches and/or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Referee of any disability prior to

**Disabilities:** the competition.

Entries: An individual shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of

which may be individual events. All seed times should be submitted to the 100<sup>th</sup> of a second. Each team may enter a maximum of four (4) individuals per event and one (1) relay per event. Entries

must be on the UIL entry form or Hy-tek zip file.
