**Rules:** Effective 2016-2017 season, deck changing is now unsportsmanlike conduct and can result in disqualification from any further events. If conduct is considered excessive, the team personnel can be removed from the meet.  
The use of audio or visual recording devices including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

**Entries:** An individual shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. All seed times should be submitted to the 100th of a second. Each team may enter a maximum of four (4) individuals per event and one (1) relay per event.

**USA Swimming Observed:** This meet will be USA swimming observed. **Please make sure that any swimmer wanting their swim to be observed has their USA Swimming ID number entered correctly.** The host will not add them manually.

**Concessions:** GISD will sell concessions on the spectator level.

**Awards:**

- Team Trophies will be awarded for Boys and Girls 1<sup>st</sup> place and runner up.
- Medals for individual and relays 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

**TISCA Championship Certificates:**

- Boy's and Girl's diver of the meet. (Winner in each event)
- Boy's and Girl's Diving Coach of the Year (coaches vote)
- Boys and Girls Swimmer of the Year determined by individual power points.
- Boys and Girls Swimming Coach of the Year voted on by coaches before the 400 Free relay starts.
- All coaches must be a member of TISCA to vote or be eligible to win award.

**Scoring:**

- Points will be earned for places 1-8 relays will be double the individual points
- Individual Points: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
- Relay Points: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

**Advancers:** Top 6 swimmers and relays per individual event will advance to the 6A Region 3 meet at Rockwall the weekend of February 6 and 7, 2026.
