**Facility:** One 8-lane competition course with 16 lanes of continuous warm up/cool down space. Fully automated Colorado Timing System with touchpads. Buttons and stopwatches will serve as backups.

**Format:** Swim will be Prelims/Finals with the top 16 qualifiers from Prelims competing in Finals. Dive will have girls and boys competing together but scored separately.

**Entries:** All team entries will be submitted using the [advancer file](#) from District Championships including a copy of the scored dive sheets. District host should send the advancer file along with a pdf of the complete District results including a copy of the scored dive sheets to Jeff Jones at [LISDAquatics@gmail.com](mailto:LISDAquatics@gmail.com) at the conclusion of their respective District Championship.

**\*\*NOTE:** This meet will be approved for observation by USA Swimming for NTV purposes. Only times achieved by swimmers who are currently registered with USA Swimming, have an accurate and **complete**

**USA Swimming ID Number in the Meet Manager Database**, and conform to the technical rules will be loaded in the SWMS Database. The athlete's USA Swimming ID must be included in your entry file. The meet host will not add them manually. \*\* Athletes 18 and over who wish for their times to be in the USA swimming database, must have completed their APT prior to the start of the meet.

**Scratches:** It is the responsibility of the coach making the scratch to notify the coach of the first alternate, and the Region Meet Director of their intention to scratch an individual or relay. It is the responsibility of the coach of the alternate to notify the Region Meet Director their intention to compete or not compete.

Scratch Deadline 11:00am Monday February 2, 2026

Scratches received after the deadline will be considered DFS and will count toward the athlete's maximum number of events.

Diving Entries: MUST BE entered in cleanentries.com by Monday February 2, 2026, at 11:00am Each diving contestant shall submit each diver's district dive sheet and diving score sheet with the swim entries, due immediately following your district meet. All NFHS and UIL Championship will apply to the meet. *Coaches who have a diver competing and are certified judges, may be asked to judge the event.*

*ALL DIVERS MUST BE LISTED ON HY-TEK entry file to score the meet*

To film on the deck for All American Consideration you must email Sherry McGuire: [mcguires@lisd.net](mailto:mcguires@lisd.net) for a film pass onto the deck.

**Entry Limit:** Each individual may compete in a maximum of four events, no more than two of which may be individual events. In relay events, eight individuals may be listed on the entry card with any four assigned to swim. This will count as an entry for each person listed only if they swim in prelims or finals. Of the eight swimmers listed, different swimmers may swim at each level (District, Region, State), send roster file.

**Entry Fee:** \$20.00 for every athlete entered in the meet and \$20.00 per relay team. Relay only swimmers and alternates will be charged.

**Packet Pick Up:** Coaches packet with heat sheets and relay cards will be available at the front office at 8:00am Friday February 6, 2026.

**Rules:** 2025-26 National Federation Rules shall govern the meet, along with University Interscholastic League Rules and Regulations.

**Scoring:** The fastest 16 swimmers in each individual and relay event will qualify for the Consolation and Championship Finals on Saturday February 7, 2026.

Points will be awarded as follows.

Individual: 20 17 16 15 14 13 12 11 9 7 6 5 4 3 2 1

Relay: 40 34 32 30 28 26 24 22 18 14 12 10 8 6 4 2

**Awards:** Medals will be awarded for first through third place in each event. Ribbons will be awards to fourth through eighth place. First through eighth place finishers in finals will be recognized during the scheduled awards breaks. The coach of the first-place finisher will hand out medals and ribbons.

Female and Male Swimmer of the Meet will be determined by NISCA Power Points. Female and Male Divers of the meet will go to the first-place finishers in the diving competition. Coach of the meet for female and male swimming will be voted on by the head coaches at the meet. Ballots must be turned in by the start of the 400 Freestyle Relays during Finals. Female and Male Diving Coaches of the meet will be awarded to the coach of the first-place female and male. Trophies will be awarded to the girls' and the boys' team champions and runner's up. The top 2 in each swimming event will automatically qualify for the UIL State Championship Meet. Also, the next eight swimmers with the best final time from the eight regional meets throughout the state will advance to the state championships. In diving events, the top three finishers will automatically advance to the State Championship meet.

**Timers:** Each district is required to provide 8 timers during the meet. Each district may decide how to divide their timers. Districts 7-6A and 8-6A will provide timers for Prelims on Friday February 6, 2026. Districts 5-6A and 6-6A will provide timers for Finals Saturday February 7, 2026.

**Officials:** All officials are required to attend the officials' meeting one hour prior to the start of each session. This meeting will review and clarify any rules necessary as well as answer questions. The uniform for Prelims will be white Polo over khaki shorts/pants/skirt. Finals will be navy polo over khaki pants/skirt. No shorts at finals. All questions regarding officials should be directed to Chuck Chinnis at [chuck@chinnis.net](mailto:chuck@chinnis.net)

**Team Seating:** All athletes are encouraged to bring chairs. There are bleachers at the facility, but not enough to give all teams seating areas.

**Admission:** \$10.00 for adults and \$5.00 for students per session.  
All Session PASS \$15 for adults and \$9.00 for students

**Heat Sheets:** Heat Sheets will be available for purchase during Prelims and Finals for \$5.00

**Hospitality:** Available for coaches and officials only.

**Bad Weather:** If there is inclement weather that effects the meet, the host will work with the UIL in rescheduling the Championship Meet. If the meet is moved to a different date the host will notify each of the 4 District Hosts with the new plan. Those four schools are responsible for passing the information on to their district.
