
Key Takeaways:

- Delivering strategic priorities are expected to increase time demands by 20%; together with offsetting some of the volunteer workload necessitates looking at ~1-2 FTE increase in paid staff.

Next Steps:

- Hold additional workshops with our head coaches to more fully explore operating requirements and ideas on how we fund them (April/May)
- Convene HOD special session (June/July) to review the outcome and vote on any necessary operational changes (staff, fees, budget)
- In second half of 2023, board works on fulfilling the plan and report back to HOD in Fall 2023 and beyond.

Age Group Report - April 16, 2023 HOD - Brandon Jones

- Worked with Cody Huckabay, Matt Franks and Kenneth Chung to ensure North Texas has a proper working meet schedule for 2024. We feel the new schedule will help to accommodate all teams in the LSC from make up of each division, meet schedule to ensuring proper events are offered at the C to BB levels.
- The Southern Age Group Zones meet has a new meet format. They are now allowing 12 boys and 12 girls from the 11-12 and 13-14 age groups, 48 swimmers total from each LSC, plus any 11-14 year old disabled athletes who wish to compete. The meet will now offer A Finals and B Finals heats per event, with no 15 and over swimmers. The meet format will now end 1 day sooner than in the past.
- Due to changing the Long Course TAGS dates, the 5 Texas LSCs will not be competing in this
 year's Southern Zones Age Group Championship. I brought up to the Southern Zone Chair that
 we need to look at possibly moving the Zones meet date to a week later. However, due to many
 teams having already planned their travel to Cary, NC, changing the meet date this summer is
 highly unlikely.
- There will be a meeting on April 26th to discuss the changes of the SZAG meet as well as any potential to move the meet a week later, accommodating the Texas LSCs in future years.

CURRENT BYLAWS

6.2.3 COMMITTEE CHAIRS/AT LARGE MEMBERS

- A. The following committee chairs shall be elected by the House of Delegates:
 - (1) Safe Sport Chair (elected in even numbered years)
 - (2) Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Chair (elected in odd numbered years)
- B. The following committee chairs shall be elected as follows:
 - (1) Officials Committee Chair shall be elected by the Officials Committee in accordance with the NTSI Policies and Procedures.
 - (2) Athlete Committee Chair shall be elected by the Athletes Committee in accordance with the NTSI Policy and Procedures.
 - (3) The Athlete At-Large Board members shall be elected by the athletes at the same time as the Athlete Representatives.

7.4 STANDING COMMITTEES
