Please consult the National Federation Swimming & Diving Rule Book for choice and order of dives. **Dive sheets must be signed and verified by 12:30.**

Rules: U.I.L. and National Federation Rules will govern the meet.

Scoring: Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relay Events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Awards: Team awards will be given to the first-third place girls' team and the first-third place boys' team. Medals will be awarded to first, second, and third place in individual and relay events. Ribbons will be awarded to fourth through eighth place in individual and relay events.

Entries: Each contestant may enter a maximum of four (4) events. No more than two (2) may be individual events (diving counts as an individual event). Top four (4) in each event from the District Championships will qualify for the Region Championships.

Coaches, please follow the directives listed below when submitting your **district** entries, as that database will follow your team and athletes all the way to the State Meet.

- For Team Abbr., use the official [UIL Team Code](#).
- Use the numeric grade level (09, 10, 11, 12) for each athlete.
- Use the School Name as listed on the UIL alignment page

*Ex: Team Abbr.: FRPC

Full Team Name: Frisco Panther Creek

Short Team Name: Panther Creek

- Do not use a mascot name or shortened name.

Dive Sheets: Use CleanEntries for submitting dive sheets. Dive sheets are due in CleanEntries at the same time Swimming and Diving entries are due. See Dive Sheet Instructions in NFHS Rules.

USAS: This meet will be approved for observation by USA Swimming for NTV purposes. Only times achieved by swimmers who are currently registered with USA Swimming, have an accurate and complete USA Swimming ID Number in the Meet Manager Database, correct spelling of name, and conform to the technical rules will be loaded into the SWMS Database. The athlete's USA swimming ID must be included in your entry file. The meet host will not add them manually.

This means you must have the swimmer's USAS # & DOB on the District Meet entry file you submit to the District Meet Director.

All USA Swimming athletes 18 years of age and older must have completed the USAS Athlete Protection Training in order for their times to be loaded into the SWMS database.

Deadlines: **District Meet directors** shall submit their Hy-tek “Advancer” file, and PDF hard copy of District results to the Region Meet Director upon conclusion of your District meet and no later than 11:59 PM on January 24, 2026. **Dive coaches** must have dive sheets submitted in CleanEntries by this time as well.

Coaches:

- Initial psych sheet will be sent by 12:00PM, Monday, January 26, 2026
- Coaches will receive a team entry report and relay name form.
 - Verify athletes entered/use relay name form to add alternates not entered from the Advancer file.
- Scratch and Relay Name submission deadline – 11:59 pm, Tuesday, January, 27, 2026.
- A final psych sheet will be emailed to coaches by 12:00 PM on Wednesday, January 28, 2026.
- Relay cards with all alternates listed are due 45 minutes prior to the start of the meet.

Scratches: It is the responsibility of the coach to contact the first alternate and the meet director of their intention to scratch an individual or relay. It is the responsibility of the coach of the alternate to notify the Meet Director of their intention to compete or not compete. Scratches must be reflected in the original team entries.

Entry Fees: \$30.00 per individual (including divers and relay-only swimmers and alternates), regardless of the number of individual events entered. Do NOT send entry fees prior to the meet. You will receive an invoice in your packet at the meet. Pay from the invoice. There is no recalculation of entry fees for scratches.

**TISCA Region Awards
2025-2026**

According to TISCA By-Laws, the following rules are in effect for the Region Championships.

The following TISCA Awards will be given at the Region Championships.

Girls Region Athlete of the Meet – Diving
Girls Region Athlete of the Meet – Swimming

Boys Region Athlete of the Meet – Diving
Boys Region Athlete of the Meet – Swimming

Girls Region Coach of the Year – Diving
Girls Region Coach of the Year – Swimming

Boys Region coach of the Year – Diving
Boys Region Coach of the Year – Swimming

The following criteria will be followed in determining the TISCA Awards:

1. Coaches must be current members of TISCA to be eligible to vote or receive a TISCA Region Coach of the Year Award. Each TISCA member will get one vote.
2. Coach of the Year Award will be determined by a vote of eligible coaches. Coaches will vote for a Girls Division coach of the Year and a Boys Division Coach of the Year for both Swimming and Diving.
3. TISCA Athlete of the Meet for Girls and Boys Swimming will be determined using NISCA Power Points. The swimmer with the highest total will be named the Athlete of the Meet for Swimming.
4. TISCA Athlete of the Meet for Girls and Boys Diving will be determined using NISCA Power Points. The diver with the highest total will be named the Athlete of the Meet for Diving.
