ABOUT THE INVITATIONAL MEET

This meet is a sanctioned, closed, inter-association YMCA Invitational meet. This meet and all participants will adhere to the Rules that Govern YMCA Competitive Sports and the Swimming Addendum to the Rules that Govern YMCA Competitive Sports. USA Swimming technical rules will be followed. The meet is YMCA sanctioned and approved by the Niagara LSC of USA Swimming.

ADJUSTMENTS TO THE MEET ANNOUCEMENTS: The host organization reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet. Changes will be communicated as far in advance as possible. None of the required elements of a sanctioned meet may be changed.

MEET TIMELINE: Warm-up and start times for all sessions are subject to change depending on the size of the meet:

10 & Under Session 1; warm-up 7:30 am, Session will begin at 9:00 am

11 & Up Session 2; warm-up 12:00 pm, Session will begin no sooner than 1:00 pm

INCLEMENT WEATHER/CANCELATION: We will make every effort to inform each team if there is a change in the meet schedule due to inclement weather.

LOCATION AND FACILITY

Location: Granby Elementary School, 400 West 7th Street North, Fulton, NY 13069

The Granby Elementary pool is configured as a 6 lane, 25-yard course. Water depth at start is 12.5 feet (minimum 5 feet required) and at turn end is 3.5 feet. Colorado electronic timing system will be used. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).

The facility provides spectator gallery seating for approximately 150 spectators. Areas outside the pool are available for families to relax in.

Swimmers will be seated in several areas including the cafeteria, gym, and hallways.



A clearly designated bullpen will be housed in the cafeteria and a holding area on the pool deck.

Absolutely no glass bottles are allowed anywhere in the facility.

There will be a TV monitor set up in the cafeteria that will livestream swim events.

NOTICES

Each team will be provided a set number of spectator passes based on team size, for entry into the spectator gallery. Spectators are asked to leave the spectator gallery at the conclusion of their swimmer's event to allow for other spectators to enter the gallery. Each team is responsible for ensuring that their assigned spectator passes are appropriately managed to allow all families access to the viewing area.

ELIGIBILITY

ATHLETE

YMCA Membership: An athlete must be a YMCA member in good standing who holds an annual, full privilege membership at the YMCA he/she represents for a period of at least 30 days prior to the first day of the meet.

Amateur Status: An athlete may not have represented a college, university or other post-high school institution in any competition and may not have accepted pay or compensation for competing as a swimmer.



Unattached Athletes: There is no "unattached" status in YMCA Swimming.

Age: Age is determined as of your age on December 1, 2023.

YMCA Meet Participation: Be a current full privileged YMCA member for the team you are representing.

Athletes with a Disability: Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary, then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition.

COACH

Required Certifications: Required Certifications: Coaches must hold current certifications in the following courses in order to receive a deck credential:

- Professional Rescuer CPR
- First Aid
- Safety Training for Swim Coaches (a lifeguard certification may be used if accompanied by completion of the Safety Training for Swim Coaches on-line content)
- Principles of YMCA Competitive Swimming and Diving

A list of the acceptable certifications can be found in the CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SWIM COACHES or SWIMMING ADDENDUM TO THE RULES THAT GOVERN YMCA COMPETITIVE SPORTS

<u>Coach Registration</u>: Each coach must have completed the annual YMCA on-line team and coach registration process prior to the entry deadline. Coaches who are not registered and approved will not be permitted on deck.

Teams without A Coach at the Meet: All athletes and teams must have at least one certified and credentialed YMCA coach designated as being responsible for their supervision during competition. When a YMCA team will not have a coach present, that YMCA may authorize an eligible coach from another YMCA attending the meet to be responsible for their athletes at the meet. The Meet Director and Meet Referee must be notified of this situation.



TEAM

<u>Team Registration:</u> Each team must have completed the annual YMCA online team registration and paid the annual registration fee prior to the entry deadline.

Insurance: Each team that participates in the meet must have a current and correct Certificate of Liability Insurance, in effect through the last day of the meet.

MEET DIRECTOR

Submit sanction application with all supporting documents and payment no later than 60 days prior to the first day of the meet. Apply for USA Swimming approval from LSC as early as possible, according to LSC deadlines and procedures. Ensure the meet is conducted in accordance with all sanction requirements (collaboratively with the meet referee and administrative official). Verify the team registration, coach registration and coach certifications (collaboratively with the regional representative) for all teams and coaches participating in the meet. Verify that all athletes age 18 and older have completed Athlete Protection Training within the past 12 months. Collect, check and scan meet declaration forms. Send scanned forms to regional representative immediately following the conclusion of the meet. Send results (Meet Manager results file) and list of participating teams, coaches and officials to regional representative and SwimCloud. Send results to LSC that issued the USA Swimming approval.

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRY LIMITS:

- 1. There are no restrictions on the number of entries per team in individual events.
- 2. The host reserves the right to limit the number of heats in certain events as well as close entries at any time.
- 3. There is no limitation to the number of mixed relays a team may enter in a relay event.
- 4. Swimmers may swim up to 4 individual events and 1 relay.

USA-S IDs: Only USA-S registered athletes should have an ID number in the Meet Entry File.



ENTRY FEES: \$5.00 per individual event

\$20.00 per relay event (\$5.00 per swimmer)

\$5.00 deck fee (one-time fee per swimmer)

OTHER: T-shirts will be available for sale prior to event through an on-line store and limited quantities/sizes will be available for sale day of event.

ENTRY DEADLINE: November 9, 2023

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Entries are to be submitted electronically. An event fill will be provided. Please email entries to nstoutenger@gmail.com. Please contact the Entry Chairperson if you do not receive confirmation within 24 hours.

OVER-SUBSCRIPTION: The Meet Manager reserves the right to close entries if the meet size exceeds 400 athletes.

VOLUNTEERS/OFFICIALS/TIMERS

OFFICIALS AND TIMERS: We will likely need the assistance of other club's officials and timers. Please inform Patrick Doran at fsd.pgboard@gmail.com if you have officials that would like to participate.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

MEET CHECK-IN PROCEDURE: Head coaches should check into the coaches' room.

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be a positive check-in for the 1000 free.

COACHES MEETING/SCRATCH MEETING: Coaches meeting will be announced prior to each session. Please provide courtesy scratches to the Admin Official.

OFFICIALS AND TIMERS MEETING: Officials and timers meeting will be announced at the meet prior to each session.

MEET PROCEDURES AND OPERATIONS

RULES: The meet will run under Rules That Govern YMCA Competitive Sports, Swimming Addendum to the Rules That Govern YMCA Competitive Sports, CNY Swim League, USA-S Technical Rules.



MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum using a timed finals format. Swimmer's age will be determined as of December 1, 2023. All relays will be mixed (2 girls and 2 boys).

EVENT SEEDING: Events will be seeded Slowest to Fastest. The Meet Referee/Administrative Official reserve the right to combine heats.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: An athlete is considered entered into an event unless he/she scratches from that event. If an athlete does not scratch from an event and does not swim the event, that event still counts toward the athlete's total number of events for the meet.

DECLARED FALSE START: An athlete may also withdraw from a heat or swim-off by electing to take a declared false start. Such declaration must be made known to the Deck Referee before the heat or swim off is announced. A declared false start counts as an event swum for the athlete and will be counted in the maximum number of events allowed for each athlete.

WARM-UP SAFETY PROCEDURES: Teams will be assigned lanes for warm-ups.

During designated warm up sessions, athletes may only enter the competition pool feet first. The exception is during specific warm-up periods when sprint lanes are designated for practicing racing starts.

READY BENCH: 10 & under swimmers and 11 & up will be bull penned in the cafeteria.

STARTS: 'Fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.

PROTEST PROCEDURE: Protests against the judgment decisions of starters, stroke, turn, place and relay take-off judges can only be considered by the Referee and the Referee's decisions will be final USA-S Rule 102.23.

CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS: The Meet Referee reserves the right to dismiss any swimmer, coach and/or spectator from the competition due to inappropriate conduct

- Deck access is limited to only registered and approved coaches, swimmers, and working officials.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- No glass containers are allowed in the building.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.



- Massage tables are not permitted.
- Individuals are responsible for the security of their personal belongings and are encouraged not to bring valuables to the meet venue and not to leave items unattended.
- Swimmers are not permitted in the spectator stands.
- Shaving is not permitted in any areas of the building.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

SCORING: Individual Events 1st – 12th place:

16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1

Relay Events 1st -12th place (place awards only, no points)

AWARDS: Heat winners and event winners will receive awards.

SPECTATORS

ADMISSION FEE: None

HEAT SHEETS: Available for sale.

CONCESSION STAND: There will be concessions available for sale.

T-SHIRTS: Will be available for purchase via an on-line store, in addition there

will be a limited quantity of t-shirts available day of invitational.

SUIT & EQUIPMENT SALES: None on site.

ATHLETE APPAREL: Swimmers must wear shirts and footwear outside the pool

deck.

HANDICAP SEATING: Will be available on the pool deck.

CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS:

- No Flash Photography at the start of competition races.
- Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children. Children are not allowed to roam the facility unattended.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Deck access is restricted to swimming athletes, coaches, officials, and meet volunteers. All non-athlete members must have proof of registration or a credential while on deck and present them upon meet management request.
- No smoking, drugs, or alcohol are permitted in the building.



LIVE STREAMING: A TV monitor will be set up in the cafeteria to view a livestream of swimming events.

LIABILITY, SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

INSURANCE: Each Association participating in this meet must have insurance coverage for representative(s) including leadership and participants who will be in attendance for the period of travel from their association to the meet, during the entire period of the meet, and return to their association. The Declaration Form must be signed by each YMCA participating in the meet.

LIABILITY LIMITS:

- In granting of the USA-S/Niagara approval, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Niagara LSC shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the meet.
- In granting the YMCA Sanctioning, it is understood and agreed that YMCA of the USA shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the meet.
- It is understood and agreed that Granby Elementary School shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the meet.

EMERGENCIES: The facility personnel will handle all emergencies at the meet. These individuals will provide CPR and first aid as needed and will ensure that individuals with serious injuries are transported immediately to the nearest hospital for further treatment. Defibrillators will be on site.

Any coach, athlete or official who recognizes an emergency situation should immediately inform the facility's personnel and then make sure the vicinity of the emergency is clear for the emergency personnel to do their job.

UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETE: Each athlete must have a certified coach responsible for him/her while on the pool deck. The coach of the athlete must authorize in writing a coach from another team to represent their team and be responsible for the swimmer(s).

CONCUSSION AWARENESS: This meet will follow the YMCA of USA Concussion procedure. Anyone who observes or has knowledge of a potential head injury should immediately notify lifeguards and/or hired medical personnel. Once the injury report is completed, the lifeguard and/or hired medical personnel will notify the Event Staff, the athlete's coaching staff, and the Meet Director.



If a head injury occurs, the action plan below will be followed:

- 1. Athlete is removed immediately from participation by the Meet Director
- 2. Athlete must be evaluated by a licensed health care professional experienced in identifying and treating concussions. In addition, the athlete must be in compliance with the laws that are in effect within the jurisdiction where the meet is held.
- 3. The coaching staff will inform the athlete's parents or guardians about the possible concussion and give or send them the fact sheet on concussion.
- 4. The athlete will not be allowed back to warm-up or compete until a health care professional, experienced in evaluating concussions determines that the athlete is symptom-free and is OK to return to participation.

LIGHTNING POLICY: The National Lightning Safety Institute, National Athletic Trainers Association, American College of Emergency Physicians, USA Swimming, and YMCA of the USA all recommend or require closing an indoor pool during an electrical storm. This policy will be followed at the meet.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE: Will be announced before each session.

PARKING

Parking is available in the parking lot directly outside of the pool entrance and in the parking lot in the front of the school, also on the side of the bus loop as long as vehicles can travel safely around the loop.

DO NOT PARK NEAR THE LOADING DOCK ON THE BACK OF THE SCHOOL. THIS AREA IS FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES ONLY.
