At the Group/Club Level

Vision and potential exists at the club, cultural, and organizational level as well. The adept coach sees what is possible for the organization, inspires others, and creates a pathway to extraordinary outcomes. He or she aligns stakeholders and unites the organization toward a common and well-defined mission, and outcomes.

Direct Application of Vision

The course walks through careful and methodical processes with regard to the development of technique, training, and competition, and begins each chapter with the construction of a vision. That vision sets in motion each of these interconnected aspects of the sport, and allows the coach, the staff, and the athletes to work in unison.

3 Methodology

The most efficient pathway to development is employing and managing a productive methodology with processes in place at every level, with common themes. With an effective and connected methodology, each group will leverage the next, and accelerate the growth and success of the overall program.

4 Culture

Culture becomes the rising tide that elevates every aspect of your program. Cultures must be cultivated, sold, and managed, every day, in every area of your program, with actions, words, and intentions. The material will go in-depth into the mechanics and maintenance of culture-building and culture-management.
