TIME SCHEDULE

MORNING SESSION: Warm-ups start at 9:00 am. Teams will be assigned warm-up lanes and times. Meet starts at 10:00 am.

<u>AFTERNOON SESSION</u>: Warm-ups will not begin before 1:00 pm. Teams will be notified of afternoon start time after all entries are received and will be assigned warm-up lanes and times. The meet will end by 6:00 pm.

FACILITY

The pool is an 8 lane, 25-yard pool. Scoring will be done using computer scoring and electronic timing with touchpads; both electronic timing and manual stop watches. The timing system will be Colorado. Water depth at the starting block end of the pool is 6 feet deep for at least 19 feet (5.79 meters) off the wall. Water depth at the shallow end of the pool is 3 feet 6 inches deep at its shallowest and deepens to 4 feet approximately 50 feet (15.24 meters) off the wall. The host will ensure the required course dimensions.

Full facility locker rooms and showers will be available. Deck changes are prohibited.

The swimmer camp is located in the gym. Despite our best efforts, the gym may be chilly. Please plan accordingly. You are welcome to bring your own chairs for use in the gym. Limited bleacher seating is available on the pool deck. No camping will be permitted on the pool deck.

FORMAT

All events are timed finals for each age group. Events will be seeded and swum mixed gender, however the events will be scored and awarded as if swum as individual gender events that were swum separately.

USA MEET INFORMATION

USA sanction number is OH-25LC-30AP. In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. (202.6.6C)

Rules

The meet will run under YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, Addendum to the YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, USA-S Technical Rules, and Southwest Ohio YMCA Swim League rules.

- In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during racing starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Operation of a drone or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, and/or spectators are present.
- Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any race.

MAAPP

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Ohio State Law

Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3314.03) requires that coaches and referees either (1) complete a free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a pupil-activity program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Free online concussion training is offered through the National Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. Training links can be found at www.swimohio.com under Safe Sport>Concussion.

Lifeguards

There will be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at all times at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4.

Technical suits



FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT³ FOR HEALTHY LIVING FOR SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

A technical suit is one that has the following components:

- a) Any suit with any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette; or
- b) Any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips.

(Note: WOVEN FABRIC – A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted.)

(Note: KNIT FABRIC – A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted.)

Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in technical suits at this meet.

- A technical suit is one that has the following components:
- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the YMCA of the USA approved child protection training course.

RESULTS

This is a timed final meet. Results will be e-mailed to each participating team, the YCO league and Ohio Swimming.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Athletes may sign up to swim up to five events in their age group, up to five events in the OPEN category **or** a combination of five events total from both the age group and OPEN categories. Only athletes who swim all five events in their age group or all five events in the OPEN category are eligible for the Top Scorer and Runner-Up awards.

Example, a 12-year-old has three options.

- A. **9-12 Events:** 50 back, 50 breast, 50 fly, 50 free & 100 IM
- B. **OPEN Events:** 200 back, 200 breast, 200 fly, 200 free & 200 IM.
- C. **9-12 Events and OPEN Events:** 100 IM, 50 Back, 50 Fly, 50 Free, 200 Breast.

Athletes swimming A and B are eligible for the Top Scorer or Runner-Up awards.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

This meet is open to YMCA swim teams. Please submit yard times for seeding.

No Time "NT" entries will not be accepted for any swimmers. Please use a best "guesstimate" of your swimmer's time when needed. Please only do this for strokes they are most likely to swim legally. We appreciate your help in enabling us to ensure that the meet runs on time.

The formats we can accept are Hy-Tek Team Manager file or Meet Manager file. Included is a Hy-Tek event list to assist you in providing an electronic entry list.

Any swimmer that is disqualified in one or more events will not be able to compete for the Pentathlon Top Scorer or Runner-Up awards.

RULES OF PLAY

CHUCK-A-DUCKS are the property of the LTPY swim team and must be returned at the completion of each contest. Each entry can be tossed into the pool only once. There will be a CHUCK-A-DUCK contest during both the morning and afternoon sessions.

Participants will stand on the "line of play" in Studio 1 and have one chance to toss their entry into the "pool". Participants will take turns CHUCKING their DUCK. Participants whose CHUCK-A-DUCK makes it into the "pool" will win a prize from the prize table located in Studio 1. Prizes will be awarded immediately after the participant CHUCKS their DUCK.
