TIME SCHEDULE

MORNING SESSION: Warm-ups start at 7:50 am. Teams will be assigned warm-up lanes and times. Meet starts at 9:00 am.

<u>AFTERNOON SESSION</u>: Warm-ups will not begin before 1 pm. Teams will be notified of afternoon start time after all entries are received and will be assigned warm-up lanes and times. The meet will end by 6:00 pm.

FACILITY

The pool is an 8 lane, 25-yard pool. Scoring will be done using computer scoring and electronic timing with touchpads; both electronic timing and manual stop watches. The timing system will be Colorado. The meet host will ensure the required course dimensions. Water depth at the starting block end of the pool is 6 feet deep for at least 19 feet (5.79 meters) off the wall. Water depth at the shallow end of the pool is 3 feet 6 inches deep at it shallowest and deepens to 4 feet approximately 50 feet (15.24 meters) off the wall.

Full facility locker rooms & showers may be available. Deck changes are prohibited.

Swimmer camp is located in the gym. Despite our best efforts, the gym may be chilly. Please plan accordingly. Limited bleacher seating is available on the pool deck. You are welcome to bring your own chairs.

FORMAT

All events are timed finals for each age group. Events will be seeded and swum mixed gender, however the events will be scored and awarded as if swum as individual gender events that were swum separately.

USA MEET INFORMATION

In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. (202.6.6C)

Rules

The meet will run under YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, Addendum to the YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, USA-S Technical Rules, and Southwest Ohio YMCA Swim League rules.

- In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Use of cameras, cell phones or any other recording device is not permitted immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) during racing starts, competition and warm-ups. Please refer to the Safe Sport section of the Ohio Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for further information regarding the use of visual recording devices.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Operation of a drone or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, and/or spectators are present.
- Flash photography is not permitted at the start off any race

MAAPP


All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the US Center for Safe Sport's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Ohio State Law

Ohio's Return to Play Law (ORC 3313.539 and ORC 3314.03) requires that coaches and referees either (1) complete a free online training once every three (3) years in recognizing the symptoms of concussion or (2) hold a pupil-activity program permit from the Ohio State Board of Education. Free online concussion training is offered through the National Federation of State High School Association and Centers of Disease Control. Training links can be found at www.swimohio.com under Safe Sport>Concussion.

Lifeguards

There will be the required number of certified lifeguard(s) on duty at all times at this meet per Ohio Administrative Code 3701-31-04-E-4.





Technical Suits

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- a) Any suit with any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette; or
- b) Any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips.

(Note: WOVEN FABRIC – A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted.)

(Note: KNIT FABRIC – A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted.)

Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.

- A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:
- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette;
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

A swimmer may swim a maximum of **THREE** individual events and **ONE** free relay. **All relays** will be mixed and must include at least one boy and one girl. (For example, a relay can include two girls and two boys or three girls and one boy).

Any points earned for 10 & under swimmers who compete in events 6, 8, 11 or 15 in the morning session will count toward their age group's high point award. Swimmer age on 12/1/23 will determine the age of participation. 10 & under morning session swims count as part of a swimmer's THREE individual event total for the meet.

Parents and Coaches may enter any 15 & Over events or relays as exhibition. There will be no entry fee cost.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

This meet is open to YMCA Swim Teams.

Please submit yard times for seeding.

Please do not enter any "NT's" (No Times) for any swimmers. Instead, use a best "guess"timate of your swimmer's time when needed. Please only do this for strokes they are most likely to swim legally.

The formats we can accept are Hy-Tek Team Manager file or Meet Manager File. Included is a Hy-Tek event list to assist you in providing an electronic entry list.

1st and 2nd Place Banner for winning team (LTPY excluded from team award).


Awards will be sorted by teams and may be picked up by coaches at the end of the meet.

There will be **no bullpen** for the **morning** session, the swimmer (and the team) is responsible for ensuring that the swimmers report to their event.





A swimmer may swim a maximum of **THREE** individual events and **ONE** free relay. Any points earned for 10 & under swimmers who compete in events 6, 8, 11 or 15 in the morning session will count toward their age group's high point award. Swimmer age on 12/1/22 will determine the age of participation. 10 & under morning session swims count as part of a swimmer's THREE individual event total for the meet.

Mixed relays must include at least one (1) boy and one (1) girl.

Combined age-group and gender events will be scored and awarded as if swum as individual age-group/gender events if the age group is noted separately.

The 50-yard stroke events are 13 & Over and will not be scored as both 13/14 and 15 & Over.
