**NEW STATE RECORD HOLDERS*

SWIMMERS OF THE MEET

Bronze

- **CJ Arledge** – She swam in her first JO meet and had great swims, especially in the 50 fly!
- **Alejandro Soto** – He had wonderful starts and great swims throughout the weekend.

Silver

- **Isabella Anton** – Isabella was the queen of 10 & under girls breaststroke with state titles in both the 50 and 100! In addition to these events, Isabella had top 4 finishes in all of her events!
- **Kaitlyn Sims** – Kaitlyn dominated the butterfly events as the state champ in the 50 fly and state runner-up in the 100 fly! In her 100 fly, she dropped 5 seconds!

Gold

- **Jason Orr** – Jason had an amazing meet at JOs! He made it back to finals in many events that he was not supposed to and had a runner-up finish in the 50 back! In addition, Jason continued to drop time through the weekend!
- **Mia Lachey** – Mia is the state champion in the 500 free with an amazing time! She also broke 2 minutes in the 200 free. She anchored the 400 free relay and out swam the Clippers to give her team the first place finish! Lastly, she finished 2nd overall in the high point standings.
- **Jordan Aurnou-Rhees** – Jordan finished 3rd overall in the high point standings as an 11 year-old! She is also the state champion in the 50 and 100 fly! She also had a lifetime best in the 50 breaststroke by 1 second!

Platinum

- **Max Dreisbach** – After already having an amazing Regional meet, Max again took his swimming to another level. He dropped even more time in all of his events and ranked in the

top 10 in every event at Junior Olympics except one, and he broke team records in the 200 Fly and 400 IM. Max also helped his relays win two bronze medals. As a 13 year old, he has set himself up nicely for next year's SC JOs.

- **Joel Serafy** – Joel had his best meet of the SC season. He had best times in every event with some impressive times. He helped his relays win bronze medals in the 200 Free Relay and 400 Medley Relay, and a 4th-place finish in the 800 Free Relay. Some of the times that really stood out were his 54.94 in 100 Fly and his 51.14 in the 100 Free.
- **Pearson Spsychalski** – In his last meet of the SC season, Pearson had all best times. He placed top 10 in all of his events. As a 13 year old, his freestyle events were most impressive, swimming a 22.96 in the 50 Free, a 49.59 in the 100 Free and a 1:47.18 in the 200 Free, breaking a team record by over half a second. Pearson also won two bronze medals in the 200 Free relay and 400 Medley relay.
- **Anisa Jones** – Anisa had her best meet of the season at JOs. She helped her teammates win a State Championship in the 11-12 girls 200 Free Relay and finished 3rd in the state in the 50 Backstroke with a personal best time of 28.99.

Senior

- **Hans Kabelka** – Hans coming off the High School season stepped up and was 1st in the 50 Free and 3rd in the 100 Free. He also helped several OSSC relays finish in the top 5 at the JO Championships. Hans also achieved a Sectional Cut time of 21.99 in the 50 Free. Great job, Hans!
