Bronze

- **CJ Arledge** – CJ placed in both the 50 & 100 breaststrokes with lifetime bests in both events.

Silver

- **Ava Lachey** – Ava had an incredible JO meet. She was the high-point winner for the 10 & under girls and also won the Most Outstanding Female Swimmer. She was a member of the national breaking relays and achieved multiple individual Ohio records. Awesome job Ava!

Gold
