### SWIMMERS OF THE MEET

#### Bronze

- **Wyatt Rathgaber** – Wyatt had a truly stunning performance in Cincinnati over the weekend. He swam to personal bests in every single one of his events, including an 8 second drop in his 200 free. Even though he will be turning 11 soon, Wyatt still picked up three 9-10 Junior Olympic cuts and also qualified for and competed in his first finals session ever. Wyatt showed up ready to compete and I am very excited to see what he can do in our final stretch of the short course season. Great job, Wyatt!!
