Two pool records topple, four narrowly missed on day four of KMSC Pro-Am Classic; Mission Viejo Nadadores wins top team award

Two pool records were broken, and four were narrowly missed on day four of the King Marlin Swim Club's Pro-Am Classic Meet. Additionally, **Mission Viejo Nadadores** (Calif.) took home the winning overall team trophy.

The four-day meet at the Oklahoma City Community College Olympic Festival Pool ended Sunday.

In addition to Mission Viejo Nadadores, other teams taking home trophies were **Schroeder YMCA Swim Team** (Wis.), who finished second overall, and **Lobo Aquatic Club** (N.M), who finished third.

Trophies were also given to the top men's and women's teams. In the men's division, **Mission Viejo Nadadores** took first; **Schroeder YMCA Swim Team**, second; and **Arkansas Dolphins Swim Team**, third.
Winning women's teams were: **Mission Viejo Nadadores**, first; **Dads Club Swim Team** (Texas), second; and **Houston Swim Team** (Texas), third.

Mission Viejo Nadadores athletes **Kathryn McLaughlin** and **Grant Shoults** earned the high point awards in the women's and men's divisions, respectively.

In exciting action Sunday night, professional **Katie Meili**, SwimMac (Carolina), smashed the pool record in the 100-yard individual medley, swimming a personal best time of 53.02. The record was 54.53 set by Whitney Burnett in 2011. Professional **Karlee Bispo**, Palo Alto Stanford Aquatics (Calif.), took second with a 53.82 finish. **Kile Carriger**, City of Midland Swim Team (Texas), swam the medley in 59.24 to claim the first amateur finish and third place overall.

In the women's 200-yard butterfly, **McLaughlin** swam a 1:54.18 to take first place and top her record of 1:54.48 set last year. Professional **Hannah Saiz**, Schroeder YMCA Swim Team, finished in 1:56.12 to claim second place, while **Macie Beairsto**, Springfield Aquatics (Mo.), had the third-place finish with a time of 2:01.41.

McLaughlin also took the win in the women's 200-yard backstroke with a time of 1:57.60. Second-place finisher, local KMSC swimmer **Rylee Linhardt** of Edmond, swam a 1:59.88 to beat **Carla Gonzales**, Fort Worth Area Swim Team (Texas), who swam the event in 2:00.86.

The men's 100-yard freestyle was the men's bounty event, paying double the prize money to professionals who break the Oklahoma or pool record. Professional **Jimmy Feigen**, New York Aquatics Club, swam a

42.75, just missing the pool record of 42.22. Professional **Giles Smith**, Phoenix Swim Club (Ariz.), swam a 43.38, just out touching professional **B.J. Hornikel**, currently unattached, who got to the wall in 43.60.

In the men's 200-yard butterfly, professional **Bobby Bollier**, Stanford Swimming (Calif.), swam a 1:43.68, narrowly missing his pool record of 1:43.35, but taking first place. **Alexandru Coci**, Phoenix Swim Club, touched the wall in 1:44.00 for second place, while **Shoults** finished third with a time of 1:46.26.

In the men's division of the 1,650-yard freestyle, the mile event, amateur **Nicholas Norman**, Mission Viejo Nadadores, swam a 14:50.78, missing the pool record by only one second. Sixth-seeded **Shane Forker**, also with Mission Viejo Nadadores, dropped 37 seconds to garner a second-place finish with a time of 15:21.35, and **Minki Kang** from South Korea and representing the Arkansas Dolphins Swim Team, earned third place with a time of 15:21.87.

Another record was almost topped in the women's 200-yard freestyle relay. **Mission Viejo Nadadores A** swam a 1:33.94, just behind the pool record of 1:33.06. **Springfield Aquatics A** (Mo.) had a second-place finish with a time of 1:35.93, and **Dads Club Swim Team A** finished third with a time of 1:36.23.

In other action, **Lauren Peterson**, Kansas City Blazers (Kan. and Mo.), dropped 12 seconds in the women's mile to take the win with a time of 16:53.01. **Jessica Storer**, Lincoln Select Swim Club (Neb.), took second with a time of 17:11.56, and **Samantha Nassif**, Mission Viejo Nadadores, took the third-place finish with a time of 17:15.13.

In the men's 100-yard individual medley, professional **Adam Mania**, Schroeder YMCA Swim Club, touched the wall in 48.26 to take first place, out touching professional **Giles Smith**, Palo Alto Stanford Aquatics, who finished in 48.42. Third place went to professional **B.J. Johnson**, Palo Alto Stanford Aquatics, who swam a 49.21.

Lauren Pitzer, Lakeside Aquatic Club (Texas), swam a 49.50 to win the women's 100-yard freestyle. She was just ahead of **Samantha Shelton**, Mission Viejo Nadadores, who touched in 50.02 for second place. **Gillian St. John**, Lobo Aquatic Club, finished in 50.78 to earn third place.

In the men's 200-yard backstroke, professional **Eugene Godsoe**, Palo Alto Stanford Aquatics, finished in 1:41.08 to claim a first-place win, and **Mania** got the second-place finish with a time of 1:43.73. **Brennan Balogh**, Lincoln Select Swimming, came in third with a time of 1:46.85.

In the men's division of the 200-yard freestyle relay, **Schroeder YMCA Swim Team A** finished in 1:21.99 to claim first. **Dads Club Swim Team** swam a 1:25.14 for second place, barely out touching **Southern Methodist University** (Texas), who finished in 1:25.75.
