Celebrating our 55th year of existence in 2025, the Chehalem Swim Team is seeking your support to help our program continue to be a tremendous community resource. Our partnership with the amazing Chehalem Aquatic Center facility, coupled with our experienced and talented coaching staff will make this one of our team's best years ever. We'd love to have you be a part of our program!

Since 1995, the Chehalem Swim Team has existed as a parent-run, coach-led 501-C-3 non-profit organization after having been founded in 1970 by the Chehalem Parks and Recreation District as a community swim team for children living in and around the district boundaries. Originally, the club's purpose was to provide a feeder system for the high school swim team.

While this remains one of the club's many functions, today the club is primarily focused on providing a comprehensive competitive swim program for kids generally between 7-18 years old in our community, regardless of whether they can pay. Over the years, CST has developed State Champions, National Age-Group Qualifiers, Junior National Qualifiers, and Masters National Champions. Many of our athletes go on to be collegiate swimmers.

We are currently Safe Sport Certified and have achieved Level One certification through USA swimming. The size of the team ranges from 100-135 swimmers depending on the time of year and we have 4 USA swimming certified coaches on staff.

In addition to in-water success, CST focuses on what swimming can do for kids beyond a medal or ribbon. Swimming is a lifelong activity that increases water safety, promotes physical health, increases emotional well-being, fosters teamwork in addition to personal success, and creates great citizens in our community. The work we do can't be done alone, and we would love to have your support.



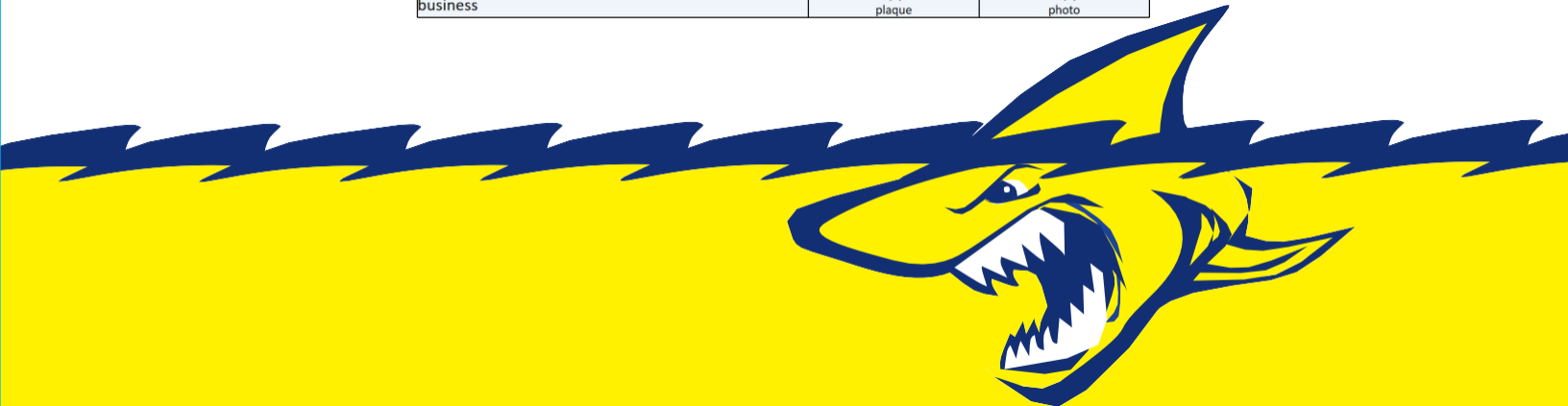
Sponsor a Shark
