PASL (Portland Area Swim League) Champs is our biggest ALL-TEAM Meet of the season. All the teams in our league (DDAC, BCAC, PAC, OCST, MAV) compete for a team championship. DDAC was victorious in the inaugural 17-18 Season, so we have to defend our title.

The Meet is formatted to have prelims and finals. The top-8 swimmers from the am prelim session will advance to swim in finals that evening. Relays will also be swum in finals. The meet is going to require parent volunteer help, so all hands on deck. Parents please be willing to help volunteer with timing, concessions, hospitality, etc.

Swimmers need to prepare for the DDAC Team Olympics every day. We want to be at our best that weekend, and that requires steady improvement towards achieving that goal. Attend practice consistently, be focused on stroke technique, and pay attention to your times in practice. Swimmers should see their racing practice times improving over the upcoming months, they should also see their strokes becoming more efficient by improving their distance per stroke, and there should also be great improvement with their performance under water off the walls and the blocks.

\$20 Business Discount Cards. The cards have discounts to 16 local businesses in Southeast Portland and Clackamas Town Center Area. Business have provided huge discounts when the card is presented at time of purchase and the card is valid until 12/31/2019. The majority of the businesses are restaurants (Burger King, Arby's, Pizanos, Charley's, Dominos, Pizza Baron, Los Arcos, Denny's, Sbarro, Baja Fresh, Papa Murphys, Old Chicago, California Pizza Kitchen), in addition KingPins Bowling Alley, Broadmoor Golf Course & 1-800 Flowers are non-food businesses that are offering excellent discounts.

All DDAC Swimmers are expected to sell 5 Business Cards to fundraise \$100 individually to the club. The fundraiser begins on Monday November 19th when swimmers will check out their 5 cards at the front desk & the fundraiser will end on Friday January 4th when all money collected and unsold cards needs to be turned in to front desk. Swimmers will be able to check out more than 5 cards after they have sold their initial 5 and throughout the fundraiser time period.

Discount Cards can be sold at the various businesses that are represented on the card, and there will be team opportunities to canvas our neighborhoods and sell to our community. Full team involvement is necessary for the club to receive the full financial benefit of the fundraiser.

Funds raised by selling the discount cards will help the club with **our team travel fund**, **equipment needs, scholarship opportunities for our families, and much more.** DDAC will receive over 70% of the total funds collected, the remaining percentage goes to Elite Fundraising who created the cards & sought out the discounts.

PRIZES!!!— There will be great prizes for the Top-3 swimmers who sell the most cards. There will be an individual prize for all swimmers that meet their expectation of selling 5 cards. In addition there will be a team event created for all those swimmers that sell their 5 cards.


