Below is a list of our Championship Meets:


- PASL Championships ALL TEAM. January 25-27th at David Douglas

- 6. OSI Senior Championships A time qualifiers. February 28- March 2 at Beaverton, OR
- Senior Sectionals Qualifiers. March 14-17th at Federal Way, WA
- 8. Age Group Sectionals Qualifiers. March 21-24 at Federal Way, WA

Swimmers and families need to look into the qualifying times for these upcoming meets and see what is possible for their swimmer to attend. DDAC will have Relays at most of the upcoming Championship meets, and those swimmers will be announced by the end of January.

Treasurer's Report

Fundraising Dollars for DDAC 2017-2018 Fiscal Year

Last year was a great year! As a team we raised **\$18,680.** Way to go team!! It is our goal as a parent run board to keep you as informed as possible. Thank you families for suggesting and inspiring this month's treasure report...

Where does our fundraising money go?

Way back in the summer of 2016, our tiny board of directors came up with DDAC's first ever annual budget. At that time we determined two key sources of revenue. 1: Monthly dues & 2: Fundraising dollars.

Monthly dues pay for expenses such as salaries, payroll expenses, pool rent, USA Registration, incentives, savings for the unforeseeable future, and big future team travel meets.

Fundraising dollars help fund the following:

- Oregon Swimming DDAC pays for our swimmers' relay meet fees. Oh yes! There is
 more to those meet fees that you pay than meets the eye! Other teams may or may not
 do this, but David Douglas prides itself on being able to pays these fees so that our swim
 families do not have to. This category also includes coaches', board members', and
 officials' registrations, as well as our annual club registrations and swimmer surcharges
 for swimmers whose parents officiate.
- Team Unify (Team Website) Our fundraising dollars also help fund our team website
 and everything in conjunction with it. It ensures we have monthly access to our site as
 well as online bill pay, TU Money, Swim-A-Thon, and helpful mobile app tools for our
 coaches (Main Set) which aid our team in running as smoothly and efficiently as
 possible.
- Office Supplies Anything from computers to postage. In the 2017-18 Fiscal year DDAC was able to purchase a printer and needed supplies to begin hosting our own swim meets, with our own tools and supplies! This line item also covers costs for business checks, deposit slips, relay and DQ slips, paper, ink cartridges, etc. etc.
- Professional Development Any certifications or background checks required by USA
 Swimming or Oregon Swimming for coaches, board members and officials, are all paid
 for using fundraising dollars so that our beloved coaches and officials are not burdened
 with this cost. It's the least we can do, because we love our coaches and officials!! Our
 coaches often attend clinics that inspire and educate them on the latest and greatest
 swim developments. Clinics keep our coaches fresh and up to date on all things swim
 related.
- Swim-A-Thon Not only is Swim-A-Thon a time to fundraise, but last year the board also voted to give back to the team in a BIG way! We were/are a new team and felt it was important to help our swimmers to look and feel unified and developed a plan to get team gear to as many swimmers as possible. We were able to give out great 1st 3rd

place prizes for top earners, DD team towels for everyone who participated, and team suits, caps and warm ups for those who collected at certain levels, as well as a Laser Tag party at Wunderland! DDAC also donated 5% of our raised funds to the USA Swimming Foundation, where their mission is to "Save lives and Build Champions!" • Scholarship Fund – Last year our scholarship fund was brand new. Scholarships are now available to those who apply, and qualify for the program. Scholarships are applied only to monthly dues which are discounted at 50%. Guidelines and expectations are listed on the application that can be found on our team site under the "documents" tab. All applications are approved by the DDAC board and must be submitted prior to the start of any given swim season.
