c. RESULTS SUMMARY:

Mar. 12-13 Valley Coast Swim League: NST sent 7 swimmers who finished in 7th place with 380 points, The seven NST swimmers included: Connor Brown, Ivan Farias, Zane Carver, Peter Perucci, Ruby Perucci, Gigi Howard, and Hana Parker collectively had 28 total swims with 19 personal bests recorded.

Mar 30 Apr 2 SCY Senior Champ: NHS sophomores Layla Bretz and Sam Postlewait represented Newport Swim Team at the Western Zone Short Course Senior Championships March 29 to April 2 in St. George, Utah. 74 teams (and over 600 swimmers) from 9 western states were represented. but both Layla and Sam were very competitive in all 11 of their races.

Apr 22-24 Newport Invit - Great racing, out of 190 total swims, we had 110 personal bests established and a team record.

Apr 30 April Showers - Zoey Chappell took two 2nd place finishes and a 3rd in the 8 & Under Girls while Braylon Belloni established 4 new personal bests, with 3 top 5 finishes in the 15 & Over boys.
