- 1. Welcome & meeting called to order at 5:30pm.
- 2. Secretary Report
 - a. September meeting minutes: Kasey motioned to accept minutes, Cheryl Seconded and minutes were approved.
- 3. Treasurer Report/ Registrar Report: Kasey motioned to approve, Mike Seconded and the report was approved.
 - a. Profit and Loss report for August/ end of the season is attached below. The season ended with \$7771.47 profit. The team is financially sustainable with a Roster of 50, and typical fundraising activities.
 - b. Team Shirts \$843.57
 - c. Caps \$675
 - d. Hoodies No direct cost to NST
 - e. Team Suits \$200 for printing costs
 - f. Registration for new swimmers: NST prorates first month's dues for new swimmers. John will come up with policy language.
- 4. Volunteer Coordinator Report Some hours have been submitted. Cheryl identified some technical issues with the system. Cheryl has drafted an email to NST families regarding the volunteer policy and instructions.
- 5. Fundraising Report
 - a. Sponsorship/Donation program: Letters went out have gone out. Grove Veterinary Clinic and Paventy and Brown Orthodontics are sponsoring NST for \$1000 each. \$900 additional funds received from Westers State, Susan Hawk and Dana Matlock, DDS.
 - i. John would like to appoint Pacific Digital, Newport Signs, and Idea as sponsors -These companies give us discounts on items purchased. Pacific Digital has not charged NST for record board upkeep. The board discussed differentiating between different levels of sponsorship.
 - ii. Booster program funds high school athletics and John was asked to contribute two baskets, one from NHS swim team, and one from NST. The fundraiser banquet is on November 12th and the basket will be available for bidding in person and online. The funds for NST basket will go directly to NST. Sharon Lihou is putting together the baskets.
- 6. Meet Director Report: N/A
- 7. Coaches Report
 - a. John has received questions from a couple of bronze families about practices in Toledo. Both families will be given the option to suspend for the month.

- b. Group Breakdown: total of 37 swimmer registered. 10 Seniors; 9 Gold; 7 Silver; 4 Bronze I; and 7 Bronze II. We may be losing one swimmer, and three are pending registration (passed tryouts), while two others pending tryouts this week.
- c. Garment updates caps are delayed and will take another two weeks. Vendors are busy, hoodies are ready for printing pending ad. John has not had a response from Ryan regarding team suites to date.
- d. Practices in Toledo, pool is rented till November 5th. Newport Pool sign indicated pool will open November 3rd. Coaches have prepped children for this transition.
- e. Meet Schedule -Past weekend kids swam well, with a number of PR's and a number of A times.
- f. Coaching Education: John did an in service for coaches going over standardized drill sheet.
- g. House of Delegate Meeting
 - i. NST in rotation for \$400 scholarship for coach training. Scholarship had to be spent by 11/1, John decided to spend on books and instructional videos. John has a coach's library currently located at his home. The items in the library will stay with NST. \$161/400 spend on materials.
 - ii. Pending changes to sanction rule, language about different type of meets. John will work with Travis on changes.
 - iii. Training for team registrars will be developed.
- h. MAAPP: Conversation around Safe Sport and training. Johns sent an email with training times from USA Swimming. John will continue to keep this a topic of conversation with the team. Coaches in the water, especially with the younger swimmers is a conversation that is happening. The board does not have a concern with this, as it is needed for new swimmers.
- i. Vinny Onestar Scholarship has been awarded to Alondra Balderas following a vote by the board. Alondra has been on the team for 4 years. She is a hard worker, has good attendance and is well liked by her teammates. Kathy and her husband hope to set up a foundation, in the meantime, they plan to provide another scholarship of \$1000 next year.
- j. Team Trip to Missoula in June for long course meet John will send survey out to gauge interest.
- k. Team Photos will be held on November 10th @ 3:15pm, ordering can be completed online.
- l. City Contract- The City has not reviewed the contract in three years, and John reports there are items they would like reflected in the contract.

8. New Business

- a. Removal of credit card merchant fees for families, last year's cost \$1,439.20: Reversing the merchant fee for CC use, especially since this is the only option for payment. Kasey indicated that this would take the fee off families and put the cost back on the team. John Motioned to approve, Cheryl seconded, and all were in favor.
- b. Introduction to team for new families -improved communication around what to expect for new families, including costs. In addition to John, a board member would be present whenever possible to facilitate communication.
- c. Fundraising 101 seminar, Nov 6 -Free training at the Maritime museum. Kasey will forward information to all.

- a. Arena sale at Pool Side Jan's -Ongoing. 9-4 M-F. John will look at stocking up for the team.
- b. John's coach contract completed-all changes were approved via email 9/15/21
