RESULTS SUMMARY:

June 24-26 TEAM Eugene Open in Eugene - 16 swimmers to the competition that included over 780 swimmers from 22 teams in Oregon and Washington. The Girls led the way with a 10th place showing, while the boys finished in 15th. 12- year old teammates Gwynn Postlewait and Ilona Weisz led the team with multiple appearance in the finals each evening. NST had a total of 58 personal best swims out of 95 total races.

July 9-10 OSI 10 & Under LC Champs/ Albany - Ivan Weisz and Jay Eibner competed at the OSI 10 & Under LC champs in Albany. Jay Eibner had the top placing for NST, taking 2nd place in the 200 Free in the 9 yr old boys age group. He also took a 4th in the 50 Free, 5th in the 200 IM and 3 6th placing in the 50 Fly, 50 and 100 Breast. Ivan took 4th in the 100 Free, 7th in the 100 Back, 9th in the 50 Back and 11th in the 50 Free. Out of a total of 10 swims, over Saturday & Sunday, the boys have 7 personal best times. Outstanding effort boys!!!!!!
