It is further understood that Oklahoma Swimming Inc., all officials, the Jenks Trojan Swim Club, Jenks Community Education, Jenks Public Schools, and the Jenks Aquatic Center shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. Damage to the facility, when proven, will cause the offending swimmer or swimmers, if unattached, or the offending swimmer's club if attached, to be accountable for repairs.

and maximum depth of 7 feet at the turning end (25y pool). 1 6-lane warm-up/cool down pool with 25-meter
lanes. 6-inch diameter Anti no-turbulence lane ropes. Deck-level overflow gutters with raised parapet at start
ends. Medium Pressure UV sanitation. Evacuator Air-handling system. Omega starting platforms with adjustable
Track Start footrest and backstroke wedge. Omega Timing System with FINA touchpads at start and turn ends; 2 8-
lane alpha-numeric multi-color LED scoreboards. The course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

Entry Rules

Limits:	Each swimmer may enter a maximum of eight (8) individual events for the entire meet. Two (2) for Friday's session and three (3) for Saturday and Sunday.		
Time Standard	No Qualifying Times will be utilized for this meet.		
Athlete Cap:	The meet is sanctioned for a maximum of 500 athletes. Entries are accepted in order of receipt. The club whose entries cause the meet to exceed the cap will be accepted in full. If entries cannot be accepted, the Entry Coordinator will notify the club(s) at that time.		
Fees:	Individual Event:\$7.00 (\$2.00 goes to OKS Aquatic Fund)Facility Surcharge:\$30.00 (\$5.00 athlete surcharge)Ind. Deck Entry:\$10.00 (\$2.00 goes to OKS Aquatic Fund)

Deck Entries:	Deck entries must be received <u>30 minutes prior to the scheduled beginning of each session</u> . Deck entries will be accepted only where space is available. Events will not be re-seeded, and new heats will not be created to accommodate deck entries. Swimmers who scratch one event and enter another event to replace it will be charged deck entry fees.		
Deadline:	The entry deadline is Thursday, September 28th, at 11:59 pm CDT, or when the Entry Limit is reached.

Meet Rules

Rulebook: Rules contained in the 2023 USA–S Rules and Regulations shall govern the meet.

Medical Supervision: Within the Jenks Aquatic Center, there are available multiple on-site AEDs, lifeguards, and a conventional First Aid Kit. Additionally, EMTs and first responders are available as required, even though they are not permanently stationed at the Aquatic Center.

MAAPP2.0: All applicable adults participating or associated with the meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP2.0), and they understand that compliance with the MAAPP2.0 policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

- **Code of Conduct:** Any individual who exhibits behavior in a threatening, abusive or derogatory manner toward an official or member of the meet operations committee is subject to immediate removal and further expulsion from the meet. Coaches will be notified of the actions of their respective team's parents whose behavior may be detrimental to the conduct of the meet. Anyone found to be misrepresenting themselves as a certified coach will be removed from the deck. The Code of Conduct for USA Swimming as outlined in Article 304.2 and 304.3 will be enforced at the meet.
- Eligibility: The meet is open only to USA Swimming-registered swimmers. Swimmer's age as of October 6th, 2023, determines age for the meet. No swimmer will be allowed to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. All swimmers must be under the direct supervision of a USA Swimming registered coach. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start, without the use of a backstroke ledge, or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Any swimmer in attendance without a coach present: USA Swimming athlete members must be under the direct supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm up, competition and warm down. The Meet Director or the Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision. OKS warm-up procedures will be enforced. USAS on deck member registration will not be accepted at this meet.
- Warm-Ups: The Warm-Up Schedule will be emailed to all coaches and posted online. Control/Supervise: Key words for safe warmups. A designated supervisor shall be on deck during the entire warm-up period. Marshalls will be actively supervising the warm-ups to ensure proper procedures are followed. Swimmers shall enter the water feet first except for starts which are limited to specified lanes or times. No paddles buoys or kick boards are allowed. In facilities that have a warm-up/cool down area different from the competition pool, meet management shall provide supervision pursuant to the rules at all times. No diving in lanes other than those designated for racing starts in an unassigned warm up session. Starting blocks will be marked to remind swimmers that they should not dive in lanes other than the designated lanes. The Meet Announcer may announce lane changes and /or warm- up changes. Coaches should understand that responsibility for supervision of their swimmers is the same at meets as when on deck at practice. Marshalls have the authority through the Meet Director and Meet Referee over warm-up. A swimmer and/or coach may be removed from the deck for interfering with the Marshall. The Meet Referee shall have the responsibility to establish and enforce rules for safe conduct within the competitive pool area during the duration of the swimming competition. There shall be at least one Marshall at each end of the warmup area to ensure the warm-up procedures will be followed. Warm-up procedures shall be enforced for any breaks scheduled during the competition.

During the Warm-up period (50 Minutes), Coaches are responsible for the conduct of racing starts or dives, from the starting end swim one-way length only.

Disabilities: Jenks Trojan Swim Club welcomes athletes with disabilities. Please alert the Meet Director to any accommodations that may be required when submitting entries.

Deck Changing: Deck changes are prohibited.

Deck Access: Access to the pool/deck area will be limited to athletes, coaches, officials, timers and OKS representatives working the meet. Officials must show their current USA-S registration card or deck pass in order to receive deck privileges. Parents and other non-swimmers not involved in the running of this meet are requested to remain in designated spectator areas. Non-Athlete Registration cards do NOT grant parents access to the pool deck at any time.

The Meet Director and Meet Referee reserve the right to limit deck access in the event of overcrowding, inappropriate behavior or for any reason concerning the safety or the efficient operation of the meet. USAS Rules of Conduct will be strictly enforced.

Safety:	Activities in the pool area that may result in injury are prohibited. Event Marshals will be appointed to monitor the activities of swimmers and spectators during warm-ups and the meet and are empowered by the safety rules of OKS to enforce the safety procedures. Repeated violations or activities that are sufficiently dangerous may result in ejection from the meet. Access to the pool/deck area will be limited as previously described. Swimmers failing to comply with the above safety rules are subject to disqualification and/or expulsion from the meet at the discretion of the Meet Referee. There are no cameras allowed behind the block, including above from the mezzanine. Anyone requesting access to the competition deck area for the purposes of team or individual photography must notify the Meet Director in advance to receive clearance. Non-Athlete Membership status is required for consideration for access for photographic purposes. Access will be restricted so as to not allow for any interruption of the successful conduct of the meet. All other photographic opportunities must be conducted from the spectator seating area. It is the responsibility of the coach and athlete to acquaint themselves with all the information contained in the Meet Letter document. USA-S Rule 202.4.9H: The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the changing area, rest rooms or locker rooms.
Drone Use:	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athletes/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
Tobacco Free:	The Jenks Trojan Aquatic Center is located on Jenks Public Schools property. Jenks Public Schools is a Tobacco-Free Zone. The use of tobacco products is strictly prohibited in all areas of Jenks Public Schools property, including parking lots, walkways, and outdoor areas. The possession of weapons or firearms upon a person or in a vehicle on JPS property is a felony offense.
Timing:	JTSC is committed to ensuring comprehensive event coverage by implementing timers for all scheduled sessions. In instances where the need for extra timers arises, JTSC will call upon invited teams for voluntary timers. This collaborative approach aims to uphold the smooth execution of all events and maintain the high standards set for our swimmers. Distance events, swimmers must provide their own counter.
Hospitality:	Hospitality will be provided to Coaches and Officials working at the meet. No Coolers will be allowed.
Concessions:	Concessions will be available for swimmers and spectators.
Meet Programs:	We will not be providing printed hard copies of the meet programs. The meet seedings will instead be made available on Meet Mobile before the start of each session. Heat sheets will be conveniently uploaded to Meet Mobile. Additionally, we will display the results in the designated areas.
Officials:	All Officials attending the meet should plan to work. Session briefings will be held 1 hour before the scheduled session starts in the classroom. Meet uniform is white over navy; white shoes; shorts, pants or skirts for timed finals or preliminary sessions. Pants or skirts for finals sessions.
