6 steps to becoming a New Oklahoma Swim Official:

Step 1: Register as a Non-Athlete member of USA Swimming. (needed yearly)

The application and instructions are available on the OKS.org website.

There is a charge associated with the membership but is typically covered by the Swim Team you are associated with, please ask your team about reimbursements.

You can also navigate to the USA swimming website.

This is where you will create a login (see highlighted button below) and access the official's information after you have created the login.

NOTE: You must have an individual account not the account shared with your swimmer(s). If you don't pay for it that won't work.

After completing the registration, you will log in for most of the other items.

Step 2: Complete a Background Check through the USA Swimming website. (needed every two years)

Log in to your USA swimming account. Migrate from the dashboard to the education tab. Find the option for background check.

There is a charge for the Background check which you must pay at the time of submission. Most Swim Clubs reimburse you once your complete certification. Please check with your team on their policy.

Step 3: Complete Athlete Protection Training through the USA Swimming website.

(needed yearly) One of our main goals as Officials is to help provide a safe environment for our athletes. One of the ways this is accomplished is ensuring all our Officials take Athlete Protection training annually.

Log in to your USA swimming account. Migrate from the dashboard to the education tab. Find the option for Athletes Protection Training.

If you have registered with USA Swimming for the first time, you need to take the "Athlete Protection Training: SafeSport™ Trained core course" After that you will take one of 3 refreshers after which you must take the Core Course again.

Step 4: Complete the Concussion Training via the below links. (this is completed once)

Log in to your USA swimming account. Migrate from the dashboard to the education tab. Find the option for Concussion Training.

Print the completion certificate so we can send to recruitofficials@oks.org and it will be added to your record and it will be filed with the information that is tracked for officials within OKS. You should see this on your record when you login to USA swimming.

Step 5: Complete the Foundations of Officiating and Stroke & Turn Officials Test/Clinic (needed every three years)

Log in to your USA swimming account. Migrate from the dashboard to the education tab. Find the option for Foundations of Officiating and the Stroke and turn.

Step 6: Work 4 Sessions as an Apprentice Official.

If you have completed the other steps you can Apprentice on Deck.
