I was born in St. Louis, one of six children, 5 boys and 1 girl. I grew up in Florissant and started swimming around age 7 along with my two older brothers. We started swimming lessons at the YMCA, progressing through the various guppies, porpoise, and shark groups. When I was around age 9, my brothers and I were looking for something else to do. We joined the local AAU team at Bangert Park in Florissant. Some of my fondest summer memories are getting out of morning practice, biking down to the local dairy store for a fudgesicle or milk shake. Some healthy eating habits being developed! My two older brothers and I swam for the Florissant Area Swim Team, the original FAST team in the area. The three of us all progressed and swam through our time in college.

For high school, I attended McCluer Senior High (at that time it was a 3 year high school). We practiced at the pool located on the campus of St. Louis Community College at Florissant Valley. I swam placing in the State Swim Meet 2 out of the 3 years. My sophomore year, we scored 4 breaststrokers in the top 12. I placed 12th. My senior year, I qualified 2nd in the 100 Breast in prelims. In the finals, I was swimming 1st through the 3rd wall. The last pullout was also my worst pullout with me finishing in 6th place. Yes, turns and pullouts do make or break a race!

I started college at St. Louis Community College at Florissant Valley which by this time I considered my home. Several other core high school swimmers also attended and swam at Flo Valley. The group of us place in Top 10 NJCA, earning myself and several others "All- American Honors". From Flo Valley, I finished my competitive swimming career at Southeast Missouri State University in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. My senior year we swam well enough to win the Missouri State Collegiate Conference.

After finishing my swimming eligibility, I returned to St. Louis attending SIUE to also complete my degree. It was also during this time that I started coaching at the Missouri Dolphins Boys and Girls Club in St. Charles. I have made coaching stops with Hazelwood Swim Club, Hazelwood Central High School, Clayton Shaw Park, Parkway, Parkway North High School, Kirkwood-Webster YMCA, HEAT, City of Dellwood, City of Crestwood, University City High School, Master Swimming @ University City, FAST, Rockwood Swim Club, back to Parkway and then again at FAST for a second time. Without leaving the St. Louis area, I have coached for many clubs and in a variety of positions. During my time as their coach, I have had swimmers achieve Junior National qualifying times, Top 10, High School State meet and State Finalists. Throughout all these coaching stops, the hard work, the focus on swimming times, I have tried to always instill an element of fun. Swimming, even top level swimming, should have periods of fun.
