

In 1990 Linda Dies was approached by several students who wanted to perform more than just once a year at the recital. They wanted more classes and showed a strong interest in dance. Linda began exploring the idea of a more "advanced group" of dancers performing at talent and dance competitions. She had four students who prepared for a competition in Buffalo, New York. They received a silver award with a very good score and nice comments from the judges. That was it! We got the "bug" to really show our stuff. So, in 1991, the Dance Express Company, our Intensive Program, was formed.

In 2011, Linda Dies "passed the torch" down to a new director, her daughter, Molly Dies. Linda's hopes were that of a fresh, innovative, rejuvenated Company - and that it was and continues to be! Yearly, Molly changes the design and setup for the competition team by introducing a variety of "new" stuff~ musicals, guest choreographers, student choreographed showcases, workouts, class levels, multiple auditions, in-house workshops, two-levels of competition teams, and anything else she can think of to keep them on their toes!

In 2016, the Company was officially changed to Molly Dies' Dance Express (but still known as L Dance Express, The Company, DE, MDDE, Intensive Program) With their slogan, "Teamwork Makes The Dream Work", the director, teachers, 30 dancers, and parents constantly continue to prove this right! "We truly are a 2nd family to each other~ the good, the bad, the ups, the downs, the tears, the laughter, the joys, the love... we are each other's people. It takes a village." This team puts in more than 20 hours a week of all things dance during this time of year. They train all-year long, with only major holidays and one summer month off, to condition, improve and grow within their art. They have what it takes to be the best versions of themselves they can be: dedication, desire, discipline, passion, focus, and commitment. These values mixed with a whole lot of hard work and never giving up, is instilled in them both at home and at the studio. This competition season the MDDE Team attended 4 Regional Dance Competitions.

The purpose of the intensive dance team is to promote dance talent at our studio for the student who displays more interest in dance at a higher level than average; to perform for organizations as entertainment in and around our community; to give our "above average" and "serious" dancers the opportunity and experience to take class from professional teachers at dance workshops and conventions; and to perform at talent competitions developing the art of dance, self-esteem, and self-confidence. Through summer auditions, dancers are placed within a company based on skill and level for that year. While in the Company, dancers get the opportunity to take classes from well known "dance names". compete with their talent, travel to places they might normally not go, and perform in a variety of places. This Company is full of dancing, learning, bonding and SO much more than JUST dancing. Over the past 30 years DE has traveled, competed, and performed in Buffalo, NY; Niagara Falls, NY; Cleveland, OH; Lancaster, PA; Pittsburgh, PA; Poconos, PA; Orlando, FL; Universal Studios, FL; Youngstown, OH; Warren, OH; Wooster, OH; Newark, NJ; New York City, NY; Myrtle Beach, SC; Virginia Beach, VA; Toledo, OH; Syracuse, NY; Big Red Boat, Carnival M.S. Imagination; Downtown Disney and MagicKingdom Parade at Walt Disney World, Orlando; Kalahari Resort, OH; Las Vegas, NV; Honolulu, HI; Royal Caribbean's Adventure of the Seas; Jamestown Jackals.

The Dance Company can also be found performing throughout the community: Warren's 4th of July Parade, Festival of the Arts, Tidioute Fishing Tournament Parade, Warren's Christmas Parade, A Christmas Spectacular, CASA Volleyball, CORE Glo-Walk, local events and more!
