

Safe Sport

- The MAAPP Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy
- Mandated by USA Swimming, it sets standards to protect athletes by regulating one-on-one interactions, electronic communication, travel, locker room and changing area. All USA Swimming clubs, Zones, and LSCs are required to fully implement this policy.
- Safe Sport Training- Parents are required to complete the training through USA swimming University.

- Parents please facilitate the completion of the online form.




Parent Code of Conduct

- Joy in the Journey: Celebrate the process of training and competing, and find meaning and enjoyment in what you do.



Armada Volunteer Requirement

Volunteering is mandatory for ALL Armada families.

Monthly Meets (if your child is participating):

Armada Volunteer Requirement

- Hosted Meets: November 8-9 & March 28-29
- Home meets are our **Primary Fundraisers** that help cover our operating expenses for the year.
- Each family is responsible for the following:
 - 10 volunteer points
 - \$25 snack bar co-op, billed to team account on 11/1
 - Earn points through Job shifts which are
 - 3-4 hours long
 - worth 2-4 points

Penalties

- Buy out: \$200/day
- No sign up = \$250 fine per swim meet day
- No shows = \$300 fine
- Late arrivals = \$25 penalty

- Access provide athletic opportunities to underserved youth in our local communities




What We Do
