



Camper Behavior Expectation Agreement

At Armada Swim & Adventure Camp, we are committed to creating a fun, inclusive, and safe environment for all campers. To ensure a positive experience, all **parents/guardians and campers must review and agree** to the following behavior expectations.

Campers are expected to:

- ✓ **Treat everyone with kindness and respect.**
- ✓ **Respect camp equipment and materials.**
- ✓ **Be considerate of others' feelings and differences.**
- ✓ **Have fun and be open to trying new things.**
- ✓ **Use appropriate language at all times.**
- ✓ **Ask a counselor for help** when facing a problem or seeing someone else struggling.
- ✓ **Take responsibility for personal belongings.**
- ✓ **Stay with their assigned group.**
- ✓ **Be in charge of their own body.** Nobody has the right to make you feel unsafe, and you should not make anyone else feel unsafe.

Behaviors to Avoid

Campers should NOT engage in the following:

- ✗ **Fighting, roughhousing, or engaging in unsafe behavior.**
- ✗ **Threatening, bullying, or joining in when others are bullying.**
- ✗ **Sharing or trading food.** (For safety and allergy reasons.)
- ✗ **Taking things that do not belong to them.**
- ✗ **Being disrespectful to staff or other campers.** This includes "trash talking" or being intentionally unkind.
- ✗ **Bringing electronics or toys from home.**
- ✗ **Bringing weapons, drugs, or alcohol to camp.**
- ✗ **Ignoring or refusing to follow staff instructions.**

Consequences for Not Meeting Expectations

Failure to follow camp expectations can create an unsafe or unpleasant experience for others. Depending on the severity and frequency of the behavior, the following steps may be taken:

- 1 Camp Directors will discuss the behavior with the camper.
- 2 If the behavior continues, Camp Directors will contact the parent/guardian.
- 3 The camper may be sent home for the day.
- 4 In extreme cases, the camper may be dismissed from camp permanently.

 **Important Note:** Armada Swim & Adventure Camp reserves the right to deny admission or remove campers who do not meet behavior expectations. **No refunds will be issued if a camper is sent home due to behavior-related concerns.**
